Tuberculosis and Bovine Brucellosis Testing
TB Testing: All cattle entered for showing
must be from a TB free or TB Accredited
and Brucellosis Free Herd.

All cattle must be TB tested negative prior to
the Show and per Regulation below and a
copy of their TB Test

All cattle must be tagged with both primary
and secondary tags - applicable AHB tags.

Certificate showing individual animal
identification numbers must be received by
the Association with entries or before 16
October at the latest.

MAF advises that Show Cattle should if
possible be TB tested using the
Comparative Cervical Test. There are now 2
documents required under MAF regulations.

a) TB Herd Status Declaration Cards:
"All cattle entered for showing which are 3
months of age and over must be
accompanied in transit by a signed and
dated TB Herd Status Declaration Card
showing either a TB Free or an Accredited
TB Free status in accordance with present
legislation." These cards may be inspected
at the unloading area.

b) TB Test Certificate and Brucellosis
Accreditation.

For cattle from Declared Movement
Controlled Areas - All Cattle over the age of
3 months are to be tested, and have a clear
test within 60 days prior to being moved to
the Show. For cattle from all other areas

a) If the herd has a C3 status or better - no
test is required provided the last whole herd
test was within 12 months prior to the Show
- OR - if the last whole herd test was not
within 12 months of the Show, then show
cattle over 1 year old must have a clear test
within 6 months prior to the Show.

b) If the herd has a status less than C3,
then show cattle over 1 year old must have
a clear test within 6 months prior to the
show.

All ages of cattle to count from 1 June.
All entries for Cattle must be registered or
eligible for their respective stud books.

Dairy Section - Please note as of 2009 RAS
Conference, a remit was passed that does
not allow teat sealing for any purposes.

Before 2yrs, 183 days - 145 - 115

Before 3yrs, 183 days - 170 - 135

After 3yrs, 183 days - 190 - 150

Production Points -

2yrs- 1 point for every 2.7kg fat, 2.2kg protein above minimum

3yrs- 1 point for every 2.8kg fat, 2.3kg protein above minimum

4yrs+ 1 point for every 3.8kg fat, 3.0kg protein above minimum

Maximum Points 50 points fat
50 points protein
100 points type
