4. Traditional requirements for costume in Equestrian, Competitors & Judges Rule Book and Guidelines.

5. Both rider and horse or pony must be named on entry form otherwise the competitor will be disqualified.

6. Horses or ponies must be owned by the competitor or his/her immediate family. Leases and Partnerships which have been registered with the Royal Agricultural Society and have been in place for at least 60 days are also permitted.

7. If competitors are not ready, they may be disqualified.

8. Rider's date of birth must be given on entry form. Age as at 1st October this year.

Judging

The winner will be a combination scoring the most points. In the event of equality of points at the end of any competition, the Judge in Ring A will select a winner in the Wyllie Cup, the judge in Ring B will select a winner in the Spark Cup, the judge in Ring C will select the winner in the Claxby Cup and the judge in Ring D will select the winner in the Perpetual Challenge Cup. For all cups the same combination of pony and rider having once won the event may compete in the same competition in succeeding years but with a penalty of 10 points. The same combination can compete in any other competition for which they are eligible in succeeding years without any penalty.

The object of these Unity Competitions is to encourage young riders to turn out a first class saddle horse/pony with good gear and raise the standard of dress of riders at A&P Shows. It will be an instruction to the judge that well-kept older gear should be marked higher than new gear.
