

MARLBOROUGH A & P ASSOCIATION RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 All entries must be made in writing to the Secretary
- 2 All entries must be made in the name of the bona fide owner of the exhibitor. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry, no entry will be valid unless these conditions are complied with. ENTRY FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE
- 3a Except in the Home Produce and Needlework Sections, and in those classes or competition which are sponsored by independent advertisers, and in those classes which are subject to age Limits, prize money in any class shall not exceed the entry fee received by the Association. Where provision applies the available entry fee shall be paid out as two thirds first, one third second. Does not apply in sponsored events
- 3b Where the provision of par 3a does not apply ,i.e. Home Produce Section, in Sponsored classes and any age Limit classes, in the event of their being no competition in any class, half the First Prize Money will be paid , three entries or no second Prize Money, five entries or no third prize money in those classes where this is offered. The Committee has the right to delete any class or competition in the event of there not being sufficient inducement of entry
- 4 Exhibitors will be require to state as accurately as possible, at time of entry, the date of birth of exhibit in classes where the age is specified, also in sheep, the date of shearing. In horse classes, ages to be computed from 1st August. In all entries of livestock the breeder's name be mentioned, if not known the fact must be stated at the time of entry. The pedigree of all stock must be given in catalogue where possible
- 5 No person shall have proprietorship for the time being in the pen which may have been allotted to the stock entered by such persons, no marks, brands or designs will be permitted in any entry in the produce classes, and no one will be permitted to put any placard or advertisement on the ground without the permission of the Committee
- 6 Supervisors shall have the power to instruct not to demonstrate
- 7 No stock shall to leave grounds before 4 p.m. on the Saturday of the Show without the permission of the Committee.
- 8 Any cow or ewe which is barren shall not be eligible to take a prize except in the fat Stock Classes. Lambs must be shown with all ewes above 16 months, unless otherwise specified
- 9 All exhibits of Implements and Machinery, Trade Exhibits, Sheep (except Fat Lambs, Pets and Flock Sheep) . Cattle (except where otherwise stated) Farm Produce, Bacon, Home and dairy Produce (except where otherwise specified) must be on the grounds by 8.30 a.m. on both days.
HORSE SECTION JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 8 A.M Both DAYS.
- NOTE A fine may be inflicted not to exceed \$1 on any exhibit coming in late, Sheep which are not in pens by 9a.m. will be disqualified from competition
- 10 In Sheep and Pigs classes the pens will be numbered to correspond with entry numbers of exhibits as stated in the catalogue.
- 11 The Committee will not under any circumstance hold themselves responsible for any damage or miss-delivery of stock or exhibits of any kind exhibited at the show.
- 12 Exhibitors and Attendants on ground at own risk and riders of horses and ponies compete at their own risk.
- 13a All protests must be in writing and may be entered either before or after the Judges have proceeded to their duties. Any person entering a protest must deposit \$50 which will be refunded , except if the protest held by the Committee to be frivolous. If any protest be lodged before the Judges proceed to their duties, the onus of disproof will rest with the exhibitor, if after that, the onus of proof will be with the person protesting. No protest will be received later than two hours after the prize tickets have been attached . The Committee, is not less than five members thereof, shall decide all protests as soon as possible, and there shall be no appeal from their decision.
- 13b All persons admitted into the Showgrounds shall be subject to the rules and orders of the Committee.
- 14 Exhibitors infringing any of the above Regulations shall be subject to be dealt with as may be decided by the Committee or sub-committee which shall be final.
- 15 The value of points shall be First Prize 5, second 3, third 2, commended 1. Stewards are instructed to place second and third tickets on all exhibits in Special Classes.
- 16 No Champion ticket or ribbon will be awarded in any section where in the opinion of the Judge, not sufficient merit is shown

17 Any prize winner of Horse Competition or Cattle sections not taking part in the Grand Parade will have prize money forfeited

- 18 No animal will be allowed to take part in the Grand Parade carrying and award or ribbons won at previous shows.
- 19 In the event of there being only one entry in a cup or trophy class, no award to be made if Judge does not consider the exhibit of sufficient merit, otherwise Cup or Trophy to be awarded
- 20 Judges are directed that stud animals having genital defects are to be disqualified
- 21 Stock suspected of being affected with any infection foot complaint or lice shall be subject to an inspection by stock inspector or a Veterinary surgeon and should the stock be found to be infected it shall be removed from the Show grounds.
- 22 Where entrant in Pony Competition and Pony Riding classes is required to be under a certain age, the entrant must not have reached that age on the day of the competition. for example--if age is shown as "under 17" competitor must not have had his or her 17th birthday on or before the date of the running of the event.
- 23 Horses and Cattle must be haltered and led by a person capable, in the opinion of the supervisors, of exercising full control of the animal, and all bulls 12 months and over in Dairy classes must be ringed or bulldogged. No stock must on any account be removed from their allotted places without the consent of the Steward or Secretary, under penalty of 50c for each offence. Pens and Places will be allotted and numbered according to sections and classes.
- 24 A Novice is a Hack, Park Hack, Saddle Hunter or Pony which has not won more than 6 first in conformation classes at any A & P Show at date of Show. Novice Horses and Ponies must be shown in snaffle bits only in novice classes. Novices may enter open classes
- 25 No horse will be permitted in judging ring wearing any prize tickets from previous events except for Championship
- 26 HEIGHT CERTIFICATES: In all cases when the height of a horse or pony is stipulated. ONLY ONE CURRENT CERTIFICATE of height must be obtained from an approved R.A.S. Measuring Machine, the certificate to be signed by authorised Steward. Where horses and ponies are measured in shoes, then, 5cm will be allowed for LIFE CERTIFICATE shoes must be removed and trimmed. Normally LIFE CERTIFICATES from any Association issued by an R.A.S. Steward are acceptable, but no horses or ponies with Life Certificate may be measured . No Horses or Pony will be allowed in height classes unless a current or Life Certificate is produced N.B: Show Associations are keeping a register and inter-changing lists. Any exhibitor who has submitted their horse/pony for measurement more than once is liable to be disqualified Annual Height Certificates will be charged at \$10 for horses or Ponies
Day Certificates available on measuring days before the Show.
- 27 That a Judge Supervisor shall have the power to direct a person to leave the ring for undue use of the spurs or whip. Excessive use of the spurs of whip whether inside or Out side the ring will not be condoned and not be more than 76.20 cm including flapper. Excessive use of Practise Jumps may lead to disqualification.
- 28 Although it is proved that horses and ponies may compete in more than one class, any or all such classes may be judged simultaneously at the convenience of the Judges or Stewards . In all such class exhibitors having an exhibit entered in more than one class must elect in which class to compete. in
- 29 Substitution of any entry can only be made on production of a Vets certificate
- 30 No Pony Hack or Show Hunter under three years to be shown in Saddle Classes
- 31 No Horse/Pony may be tied to or led amongst cars. Horses/Ponies MUST be kept at floats or tied to rails and/or in boxes, yards and/or stalls. Any offender could be excluded from competing in the show.
- 32 All Stallions must be shown in bridle and bit . Any uncontrolled exhibits may be removed from the grounds by order of the Chairperson of the Horse Committee.
- 33 A competitor may not ride more than one Horse/Pony in any one Flat Class
- 34 All Horse/Ponies brought out for champion selection must be ridden by same rider as in qualifying classes
