SHEEP

Judging 9 am

Conditions in the Sheep Classes

All sheep must be on the ground and penned by 9am on Saturday ready for judging. Sheep arriving later than 9am will be liable for disqualification.

Brucella Ovis - see rule No. 36.

No restriction as to feeding. No exhibit will be allowed on the ground if suffering from footrot. All sheep entered in the Breed Classes must be entered in their respective flock books. All sheep to be considered to be bred by exhibitor unless otherwise stated. If requested by the Assn exhibitors must furnish a declaration that the sheep are eligible, by reason of age, to compete in the class for which they entered.

Unless otherwise stated, no sheep shown in the wool shall have been shorn earlier than 20 July 2009 apart from mutton breed sheep which must be shorn on or after 1 September 2009. Judges will be instructed not to award prizes to sheep which they consider unfairly shorn or excessively coloured, also to disqualify sheep on which an adhesive substance, string or other material has been used for the purpose of concealing or altering any defect in the fleece or the form of the sheep.

All prize winners to pick up their prize voucher and money from the Class Steward. In Natural Condition Class,

exhibitors will be required to sign the declaration in Rule 35 of the General Rules and Regulations.

Exhibitors are reminded that the use of bloom dip or artificial colouring is now covered by Government regulations.
