

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE HELENSVILLE AGRICULTURAL & PASTORAL ASSOCIATION

To be read in conjunction with the relevant section conditions and the Rules and By-Laws of the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand.

Privacy Act

The Association holds records of names and addresses of all members and competitors and may publish these for the purposes of Show, media reports, or promotional purposes at the Association's discretion. The Association may take photographs and video images of members, competitors, exhibits (including livestock) and the employees, agents and assistants of any competitor, and use this information for reporting or promotional purposes in any media at the Association's discretion. If you do not wish to have a photograph of you/or your exhibit used by the Helensville A&P Assn for publicity, please notify the office

Rights of the Helensville A&P Committee

The Helensville A&P Committee reserves the right to, at any time, for any reason, and without notice (i) refuse or cancel any entry; (ii) alter the Show timetable; (iii) withdraw or change any event or class; (iv) request the removal from the Show grounds of animals deemed unruly or dangerous, and (v) remove any dangerous or inappropriate exhibit or display.

Protests

All protests must be in writing and may be lodged with the Secretary one hour from the completion of the class judged, together with a deposit of \$50.00 which shall be returned should the protest be sustained. Should the protest be lodged before the judges proceed to their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the competitor; thereafter, the onus of proof will be with the party protesting. No protest will be received later than one hour after the prize tickets/ribbons are affixed.

The Helensville A&P Committee, or not less than five members thereof, will determine the results of all protests as soon as practicable. There shall be no appeal.

Health & Safety

· The Association will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by an exhibit, or which may be caused directly or indirectly by any other exhibit, notwithstanding any alleged negligence on the part of any officer or servant of the Association, and it shall be a condition of entry that each competitor shall hold the Association indemnified against any claim in respect of any such accident, loss or damage caused by any exhibit of such competitors. By signing the entry form declaration, competitors accept the Association's conditions of entry and indemnify the Association under the provisions of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015.

· Each competitor must always supervise and control their animals and shall be liable for any hazards created or accidents, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.

· Competitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015.

· The Association reserves the right to order immediate removal from the Showgrounds any animal it considers unruly or dangerous.

· It is the Association's policy to see that all due care is taken to protect property and to protect and to keep in efficient order its own property, and to make provision for the protection of the property of others, but the Association shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect howsoever arising.

· Persons occupying grandstands, buildings, other structures or other seating accommodation on the Show grounds do so at their own risk, and no claim shall be made against the Association in respect of any loss, or injury by reason of any defect of accident, or by reason of any act or omission whether negligent or otherwise, on the part of the Association or of any employee or agent of the Association or on the part of any other person.

· Parking is entirely at the owner's own risk. Any vehicles parked will be on this condition and the Association accepts no responsibility for any loss, theft, injury or damage attributed to any negligence on the part of the Association, its employees or stewards.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries Close Friday 8 February 2019, 4pm

THERE WILL BE NO LATE ENTRIES. ORIGINAL OFFICIAL RAS HEIGHT CERTIFICATES MUST BE CARRIED ON THE DAY TO GAIN ACCESS TO THE RING

Completion of Entry Forms

· Entries must be made on the official entry forms, online and accompanied by full payment, and be received by the Show Secretary on or before the closing dates and times as advertised in the schedule and online.

NEW 2019: Please ensure your bank details are entered on your entry form for prize money to be paid.

· Incomplete, incorrect or unsigned entry forms will be returned to competitors for correction. This applies to all competitors, including members of the Association that have not as yet paid their annual subscription but who have calculated entry fees using the discount available to members.

· A copy of current RAS height certificates and performance cards, where applicable, must be forwarded with your entry, and carried on the day of competition and produced on request.

Final Helensville measuring day Sunday the **3rd of February 2019**. There will be **no** special measures for Helensville Show entries after this date.

· All entries must be made in the name of the bona-fide owner of the exhibits ("the Competitor"), and such exhibits must have been the property of the Competitor at the time of entry. Registered lessees of animals are permitted to enter under their own name.

Membership

· Children of members up to the age of 16 years are eligible to claim entry fee discount.

· New members - Discounted membership entry fees are available to current members of the Helensville A&P Association. The Association's membership form may be completed and forwarded with entries. A membership application form is at the back of this Schedule or email info@helensvilleshow.co.nz

Membership Subscriptions

· Annual individual membership of the Helensville A&P Association is \$30.00. The membership year runs from 1 June – 31 May. See application form in the back of this schedule.

Confirmation of Entries

· Confirmation of entries - A confirmation of entries showing all details of your entries will be returned to competitor following data processing. Your entry form will NOT be returned to you.

· **Responsibility** - It will be the competitor's responsibility, to check the details on the confirmation of entries carefully and ensure that all details are correct. Any alterations to classes must be made to the Secretary by Monday 11 February 2019 in writing (email). **NO EXCEPTIONS** - saving Novice upgrading changes - see Conditions & Regulations of the Equestrian & Livestock Sections - Classification.

Substitutions

Substitutions must be advised in writing by 12 noon Tuesday 12 February 2019. Substitutions will only be accepted for the same number of entries already entered. No additional entries will be accepted.

Refund of Entry Fee

Competitors desiring a refund of entry fees must apply in writing enclosing a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate within SEVEN DAYS of the Show. Such applications will be considered by the committee, and if successful, refund will be made less 25%.

Competitor Entry Passes

Will be issued for postal entries only according to the following schedule - Horses – 2 passes per horse to a maximum of 4.

Instructions to Judges and Stewards

Judges to report to the Secretary on arrival. If the judges, consider that any exhibit does not come within the regulations they are requested to report it to the senior steward of the class. In the event of there being no competition in any class, prizes may be given if the judges certify to a particular merit, but they are specially requested to withhold prizes, even where there is competition, if the exhibits are of inferior description, or not suitable for the class in which they are competing. The judges will be provided with a book containing the list of classes to be judged and prizes allotted thereto, and each judge is particularly requested to note in their book the number of the lot to which they award the prizes in the various classes and sign the same.

Local

Local owner or local competitor is defined as resident within the area of the Kumeu subdivision of the Auckland Council.

Exhibiting

Competitors will be called only twice to the ring at which time they will be automatically scratched.

All scratchings must be advised to the steward as soon as possible.

Health of Animal

The Helensville A&P Association shall not be responsible for any loss or damage caused (inter alia) through disease or infection however arising. Each competitor shall have deemed to have guaranteed to the Helensville A&P Association and have given warranty that each exhibit entered and brought to the Showgrounds is free of any contagious or infectious disease.

Clean Sport

The use of tranquillizers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance of horses and ponies is forbidden.

Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Clean Sport Testing will be carried out under the Royal Agricultural Society (Incorporated) Clean Sport Judicial Committee (CSJC) procedures and rules.

Your signature on the entry form and/or participation in competition denotes acceptance of these conditions. (Ref. 89CS of RAS Equestrian Rule Book).

"Yellow Card" System

This Show supports the RAS "Yellow Card" system, which will operate in the Equestrian Section of all RAS affiliated shows and will be offered for any inappropriate behavior towards show officials, judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bringing the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the conduct of members, owners, lessees, competitors and/or competitors as provided in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rule Book and rule 13 of the RAS Constitution.

Implementation of the "Yellow Card" will be in accordance of the RAS Rules that accompany the card. The full working of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website.

CLASSIFICATIONS

Novice – A novice horse, pony or rider is one that has yet to win six classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A&P Show. Upon achieving the sixth win in a division, a pony, horse or rider must then compete in the appropriate open classes within that division.

Open – All horses, ponies and riders that have won six classes within a designated section (as above). All may enter in open classes.

HEIGHT CERTIFICATES

A current RAS height certificates & performance cards, where applicable, must be carried on the day of competition and produced on request. **You will not be permitted to enter the ring on Show day before presenting your original current RAS height certificate to the steward.**

CHAMPIONSHIPS

In all rings, first prize winners only to parade for Champion. Once the Champion has been selected the second placed horse to the Champion **MUST** be allowed to parade for the judging of the Reserve Champion.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money in all classes will be awarded in full. All prize money will be paid out no later than two days after Show day to the designated bank account number. All prizes are subject to confirmation from sponsors.

VALUE OF POINTS

The Points for prizes are as follows:

First Prize	counts 6 points
Second Prize	counts 4 points
Third Prize	counts 2 points
Highly Commended	counts 1 point
Champion	counts 2 points
Reserve Champion	counts 1 point

In the event of a tie, the largest number of first prizes will decide the matter, and if that fails to decide, then the value of the prize will be divided equally amongst those who have tied.

SAFETY HELMETS

All riders, including harness drivers/with the exclusion of heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds or the grounds of an affiliated Event.

Hats/ Helmets must conform to one of the current approved safety standards. These standards may be subject to change, but the latest list can be found at www.ras.org.nz-equestrian, RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook.

All hats/helmets that conform as must be identified by the current tag system implemented by NZPCA, ESNZ and RAS.

All helmets must have a red tag.


