## Conditions of Entry

1. PLAITING OPTIONAL
2. Jackets or Pony Club uniform acceptable.
3. No Horses/Ponies under 3years old may compete in ridden classes.
4. Horses/ponies entered in Youngstock classes must be 3years or under.
5. Colts over 6 months of age to be shown with a bit in mouth.
6. Height certificates must be carried where height is stipulated. Must be Current.
7. A novice is a horse/pony, which has not won six 1<sup>st</sup> in **any** conformation classes at any A& P, Open Pony Club show, Breed or Riding Club Shows.
8. Riders may enter one riding class only. Riders age to be calculated at close of entry.
9. No consideration will be given to exhibitors entered in more than one section.
10. In all classes latecomers will NOT be accepted into ring once judging has commenced.
11. Any horse/pony that may kick, please indicate with a red ribbon in its tail.
12. Competitors are expected to observe good manners and etiquette. Unnecessary rudeness may result in a competitor being disqualified.
13. Refund of 75% of entry fee where a veterinary surgeon or doctors certificate is produced within 7 days. A horse/pony may be substituted on production of a vet certificate provided a substitute is eligible for the class.
14. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving reason for doing so and reserves the right to alter, delete or combine classes as they see fit.
15. The organisers and Society will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be suffered by any exhibit, person or property, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any accidental loss, damage. Exhibitors or owners signature on the entry form and or participation in the show denotes acceptance of these conditions.
16. Entries must be made on the official entry form accompanied by total entry fees and must be in the hands of the secretary by closing date.
17. Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in, schooling or riding for any reason a horse or pony at the Show or in any area considered to be for whatever reason a part of the Showground's at the Show.
18. All riders 16years and under must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than 2 points. Such head gear must be worn with a chin strap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within the Showgrounds.
19. The definition of a broodmare is a mare who has a foal at foot, however if an early foal (foaled since 1/8/14) has been weaned, the mare must be back in foal with a spring due date confirmed with a veterinary certificate, available on request.
20. The show will be run under the guidance of the RAS Rules.
21. Ponies to be ridden by riders 16years and under, EXCEPT for Novice Ponies, these may be ridden by Adults in the Novice Classes only.  
( Adults may also ride ponies in the Coloured Horse/Pony Section.)
22. Judges are correct at time of printing the schedule however due to circumstances beyond our control at time of show they may change.

**ENTRIES CLOSE: Saturday 27th December 2014.** Late/post entries may be accepted providing a late fee of 50% of the entry fees is added to the fees paid.

The committee reserves the right to combine classes if there are insufficient entries.
