**Inhand Pinto**

All Pintos must be registered with the NZ Pinto Horse Society Inc & owner a current financial member at close of entries.

You must choose to enter your horse into either Pinto Saddle Hunter or Pinto Show Horse. Once chosen you cannot change classification for that season. Only applies to classes with these classifications.

1. Best Presented Pinto & Handler
2. Best Colour & Patterned
3. Best Paced
4. Best Mannered
5. Foal or Yearling
6. 2 or 3 year old

Champion & Reserve Youngstock Pinto - *judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters of classes 5 & 6, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetters to stand by*

7. Show Horse any height – 4 years & over
8. Saddle Hunter any height - 4 years & over

Champion & Reserve Adult Pinto - *judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters of classes 7 & 8, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetters to stand by*  
Supreme Champion Pinto - *judged from Champion winners*

9. Best Presented Pinto & Rider
10. Best Paced
11. Best Mannered
12. Novice 0-5 wins - any height
13. Open Pony – under 148cm
14. Open Show Horse – over 148cm
15. Open Saddle Hunter – over 148cm
