
## **Various Snaffle Bits**

- 1. Ordinary snaffle with single jointed mouthpiece
- 2. Double jointed snaffles (a, b, c)
- 3. Racing snaffle (d-ring)
- 4. Snaffle
  - (a) with checks, with or without keepers
  - (b) without cheeks (eggbutt)
- 5. Snaffle with upper or lower cheeks
- 6. Unjointed snaffle (mullen mouth)
- 7. Snaffle with cheeks (hanging or drop cheek, Baucher) (this may be a D-ring or other ordinary snaffle as pictured in numbers 1-6)
- 8. Fulmer
- 9. French snaffle
- 10. Snaffle with rotating mouthpiece
- 11. Snaffle with rotating middle piece
- 12. Happy mouth with roller
- 13. Bevel snaffle.



## **RAS RULE**

## **CDE 2. LEAD REIN**

d) The lead must be attached to the caveson of a simple snaffle bridle.

## **CDE 3. FIRST RIDDEN COMBINATION**

d) First Ridden Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with a caveson noseband, a snaffle bit and a single rein.
