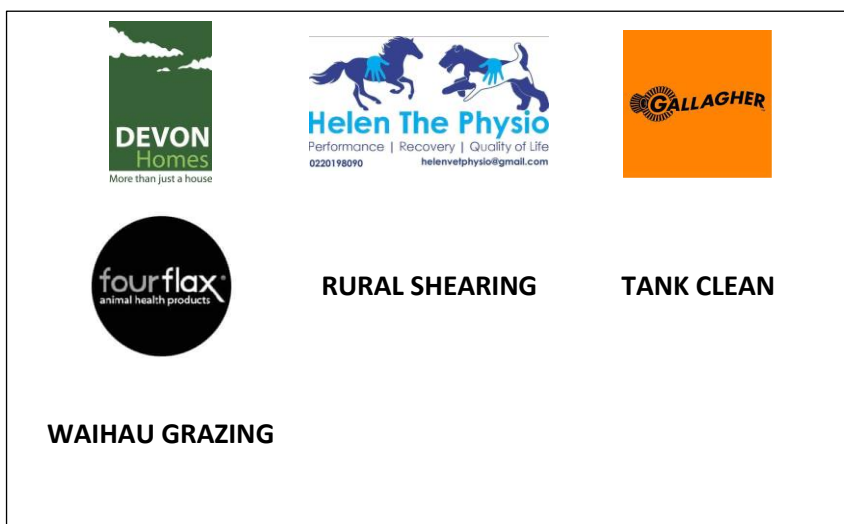

SHOW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Important: Entry to the oval is via Anson Street unless assigned to camping area "A". Please check when gates will be open on both days as if you arrive too early this will cause a traffic jam on a major bypass.

Entries

All entries are to be through EVO EVENTS (previously equestrian entries) website (www.evoevents.co.nz), with the use of Polipay – no exceptions. If you are unfamiliar with either of these processes, please do not leave it until the last minute. Problems encountered with the Evo Events website should be directed to Evo Events, using the website chat function or phone 021 684 858 and not to the Wanganui A&P Show committee. Entries will not be accepted or processed until payment has been received. **Entries close Sunday 6th November 2022.**

Existing competitors can enter more horses or extra classes on the day with a 50% late fee added. (Any fees for an extra horse will still apply and no new competitors can enter on the day).

Yarding cannot be guaranteed for all entries; however, we will do our absolute best.

Class changes during the show will incur a \$3 fee.

Ground levy of \$10 per horse. This will be capped at \$30 for anyone who brings 3 or more horses.

Rider levy of \$15 per rider - this includes the rider first aid levy.

Prize Money

All prize money will be paid out to the bank account number on your Evo events account within three weeks of the show. All prizes and prize money are GST inclusive.

Refunds and Scratching's

The Association will refund 80% of entry fees on scratching's or withdrawals on or before Wednesday 9th November. Scratching's subsequent to this date will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Refunds will be processed after the show - no refunding of \$10 or less.

Horse of the Year Qualifying Show

The Wanganui A & P Show is a qualifying show for Horse of the Year 2023.

Access and Camping

Camping is available on the grounds for Friday night and Saturday night, Sunday night is to be arranged directly with the show committee. Please park in the correct areas; signage will be up from 10am on Friday.

Please select the \$0 camping fee on Evo events when entering and please state which nights you will be staying as this will help us designate your camping spot.

There will be two camping spots.

CAMPING A: This will be in the racecourse carpark, entrance for this will be off PURNELL STREET. We will be filling up this area first and there will be someone there to advise you where to park. We will try our best to put your horses/ponies as close as possible to you.

CAMPING B: This will be in the oval near the portable yards this will not be used until camping A is full. Entrance for this will be off ANSON street.

Parking

The clearways allow for competitor/spectator/emergency and staff access. All designated clearways marked by cones are to be kept free of parked vehicles during the running of the show. All hay and manure must be raked up and dumped in correct places.

Head Wear Red Tagged helmets are to be worn at all times when mounted. Please note that from August 2023 new standards imposed – a yellow tag is to be worn-

Yards & Stables

These are available Friday and Saturday nights. Boxes are \$40 and Uncovered Yards are \$30 for the duration of the show. Booking is essential. No temporary fence accommodation is permitted. Yard allocation will be emailed out prior to the show. Please leave your yards and boxes clean. A fine of \$50 will be imposed on yards and boxes that are not mucked out. There is no refund of cancelled entries for yards as we will have already booked, transported and paid for them. Yarding cannot be guaranteed for late entries so please get your entries in on time if you have specific yarding requirements. All yarding requests will be given to the best of our abilities on a first serve basis so get your entries in early to ensure your requests are filled to the best of our abilities.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome. **There will be a \$50 fine for any dog caught on the premises that is not on a lead and under control or near the racecourse running rails in the morning while racehorses are working.**

“new racecourse rule” there are to be no dogs in or around the racecourse stables and yards area. if any committee sees this rule being broken you will be asked to pack up and leave as if we do not follow racecourse rules we will lose the use of the grounds.

RAS

The RAS Equestrian Rulebook (www.ras.org.nz) sets out all conditions applying to showing classes offered. All entry fees to all show ring and show jumping classes include a \$1.15 RAS levy.

RAS Height Certificates/Novice Performance Cards must be carried at all times and presented on request. No card – no start. No exceptions.

Yellow Card - This Show/Event supports the RAS ‘Yellow Card’ system. A Yellow Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the ‘Yellow Card’ system is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz.

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the responsible person’s risk.

Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

Arrears -No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

Summary of RAS Resolution Process – the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases, it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regard to an RAS official, the it is to be forwarded on to the RAS CEO who will deal with it appropriately.

Riders- riders’ age is taken as on the 1st of August 2022

ESNZ

All jumping classes are run under ESNZ rules. With the exception of Introductory classes all riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership. Horses registered with ESNZ but NOT currently registered for Jumping/Show Hunter (excluding Introductory level) must pay the ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy of \$20 per show for all non-series classes. Height restrictions of Horses:1.10m and Ponies 1m apply. Riders must have full ESNZ membership. All horses/ponies must pay an ESNZ \$5 jumping levy.

Horse/Pony Hunter Derby

Conditions for the Derby are Judged on the following elements: Jumping, Manners, Conformation & Type, and Way of Going. 1. To be judged in two phases. Phase One – Jumping, Phase Two – Flat section. 2. No restriction on gear except Bit less bridles are not permitted, and Draw reins (running reins, Market Harborough's) are forbidden. Boots may be used, but not permitted in Phase Two. 3. Whips not to exceed 75cm. 4. No gear changes between phases except boots must be removed for Phase Two. 5. The course will include a water jump/liverpool. No time limit, hunting pace. 6. Phase One Jumping will be completed first. Any Pony/Horse eliminated will not be required for Phase Two. Marking PHASE ONE Jumping 100 (All clears 100) Style & Manners while jumping 20 Marking PHASE TWO Manners & Way of Going 10 Conformation, type & freedom of action 20 TOTAL 150 Penalties PHASE ONE Jumping Knock Down 10 First Refusal 15 Second Refusal 20 Third Refusal Elimination. Fall of Horse/Pony or Rider in either phases Elimination. No penalty is incurred if the lower pole in the same vertical plane is lowered. If a horse/pony positively stops or turns its quarters to a fence or has a complete turnabout these constitute refusals. Horses/ponies displaying continued disobedience or horses/ponies leaving the ring whether mounted or dismounted will be eliminated. Any horse/pony taking the wrong course or jumping another fence after completing the course will be eliminated. TIE BREAKER in the event of a tie or ties the mark **MUST NOT** be altered. The TOTAL MARK from PHASE One will take precedence, followed by the Manners Mark, and then the Conformation Mark. If there is still a tie the Judge's decision is FINAL.

Show Hunter

All Show Hunter will be run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2022 and Equitation Series Conditions 2022. Please refer to ESNZ website for Show Hunter Rule changes. Our stewards will be enforcing these. Equines competing in series classes must have full ESNZ Registration and a Current Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start. Equines competing using the ESNZ Jumping Casual Levy cannot

compete in any Show Hunter Series Classes. Introductory classes do not carry HOY qualifying points. Classes may be run back-to-back.

Wanganui Petre Pony Club Show Jumping Ring 3 Open to all riders, NZPCA casual membership form must be completed, signed and returned by all non-pony club members prior to competing. Run under NZPCA rules.

Quad Bikes

Quad Bikes/and or any motorized Bikes - All riders must wear a helmet at all times. This is inclusive of pillion passengers. No more than one pillion passenger is allowed per bike. Speed is restricted to no more than 10kms per hour. All drivers of ANY bike must hold the appropriate licenses/endorsements to operate the vehicle. No quads in the narrow access ways between yards

Legal Liability

Our Association's Public Liability Policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors.

Protests

Protests must be lodged in writing with the secretary no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event concerned. A deposit of \$50 must accompany each protest. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Health and Safety

We will take responsibility for Health and Safety procedures, however all people on this site need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the events Health and Safety policy. Competitors will be responsible for themselves at all times by observing safe practices/instructions relating to their competition.

By entering the Wanganui, A&P Show (The Event) all competitors are understood to have agreed with the following statements.

I declare that:

1. My accepted entry into the Event will not be transferred to another entrant.
2. In the event of any 'act of God' conditions causing a cancellation of the Event, I agree that my total entry fee is not transferable or refundable.
3. I am in an appropriate physical condition to participate in the Event, given the known parameters of the Event (such as the length, time, physical demands and environmental context).
4. I have taken medical advice on any pre-existing medical conditions, and confirm that it is medically safe for me to participate in the Event.
5. I acknowledge that there are risks involved in the Event. I fully realize the dangers of participating in the Event, and fully assume the risks associated with my participation and my wellbeing and safety during and after the Event. I understand and acknowledge that the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers) provide no warranties, regarding my wellbeing and safety.
6. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the Event, which may be beyond the immediate control of the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers).
7. I will participate in the Event, in a manner that does not endanger either me or others.
8. I agree that to the extent permissible by law, the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers), the sponsors and other parties associated with the Event, have no liability to me whatsoever for any direct or indirect loss, (including, but not limited to injury or death) sustained by me during or in any way related to my participation in the Event.
9. I authorise the use of my name, voice, picture and information on this entry form in any broadcast, telecast, promotion, advertising, and in any other way, without payment to me or any other form of compensation.

10. I agree to comply with the rules, and regulations pertaining to the Event.
11. I agree to follow all reasonable safety instructions provided to me by the Event organisers, (including all officials and event volunteers) before, during and after the Event.
12. I consent to receiving medical treatment in the event of illness or injuries suffered during or immediately after the Event.

Love Racing

Overall points prize for leading registered Thoroughbred jumper kindly sponsored by Love Racing. Excludes all intro and equitation classes.

Stallions

All stallions and colts must wear a bit at all times. It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS Head Office.

Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring.

Mares

A 'Dry' mare is a mare not to foal during the current show season (1 August to 31 July).

Mares shown in Brood Mare classes must have a foal at foot or present a veterinary certificate of pregnancy that includes a projected foaling date. Mares shown in the summer season without a foal at foot, would be expected (before Christmas) to be late foaling in the summer or autumn, or (after Christmas) to have weaned an early foal and be back in foal with a spring due date. Mare's falling into either of the above categories should prove their eligibility with a veterinary certificate. Anything less will be unacceptable. Broodmares with foal at foot are ineligible for ridden classes.

Competition numbers

These are to be displayed in all rings apart from any classes that involve jumping and any pleasure rings.

These will be emailed out prior to the show alongside any yarding numbers and any other important information you may need.

Wanganui Jockey Club

Without the generosity of the WJC we would not be able to have our show. Please respect the following WJC requests:

Remove all rubbish to wheelie bins, remove all hay to fire pit near Oval Yards

Protests

Protests must be lodged in writing with the secretary no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event concerned. A deposit of \$50 must accompany each protest. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Presentation area

This area has been decorated for the purposes of capturing sponsored presentations and anyone else who wishes to take advantage of it with taking pictures of your horses or ponies with ribbons, rugs or any other prizes. We will not have an assigned photographer in this area but you are welcome to take your own pictures or find a photographer on the grounds to use.

The organising committee reserves the right to alter, amend, combine or delete any classes or start times as they see fit. If numbers are insufficient at close of entries it may be necessary to cancel or combine some classes. Any cancellations will be notified to the competitors Evo Events email address by Tuesday 8th November.

RACECOURSE TRACK CROSSINGS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

CROSSING THE RACECOURSE TRACK

Crossing the racecourse track to go in and out the grounds or to access stables and yards that are over that side will only be accessible at certain times. We know this isn't ideal as people like to feed animals early and other situations like that but these have to be followed and there will be a committee member monitoring this. We cannot get around this or change this as it is a working/training track and if we upset any trainers or racecourse staff, we will lose the use of the grounds.

There is to be no horses on the training tracks at any time, this includes walking them or grazing them.

Access to the stables and the yards over that side of the grounds are as followed.

SATURDAY MORNING: Access will be from 7:30am (or until last racehorse has left the tie up area, this could be slightly early or later depending on horses working that day)

SUNDAY MORNING: Access will be from 6:30am.

A committee member will be monitoring the gaps and will be in communication with racecourse management as you will be given the all clear as soon as possible.

MAIN ENTERANCE GATE (ANSON STREET)

This gate will be locked and unlocked at certain times throughout the weekend to ensure the safety of the horses on the grounds and also the racehorses that will be schooling in the mornings. There is to be no vehicles on any of the tracks at any time.

Gate times are as followed:

FRIDAY 12TH: Gates will be open from 10am for anyone who wishes to arrive early. Gates will then be locked at 10pm so please ensure if you go anywhere, you are back by then.

SATURDAY 13TH: Gate will be unlocked at 8:00am or when we are sure there are no more racehorses training. Gates will then be locked again at 10pm.

SUNDAY 14TH: Gate will be unlocked at 6:45am.

Saturday Night Get Together

We will be holding our annual Saturday evening get together again this year holding some competitions for people to participate in and win some prizes.

We will also have dinner available; it will be \$10 per plate. Bring cash to purchase dinner from the marquee.

This will start approximately 30mins after the last show jumping class in ring 1 or around 5pm, We will announce over the loud speaker on the day a time we will be running this.
