HORSE & PONY SHOW ASSOCIATION

Rules & Conditions (as per NZ National Horse & Pony Show) & (RAS Equestrian Rules)

- 1. Entries Open Monday 21st November 2022
- 2. Entries Close Friday 16th December 2022 at midnight
- Late entries accepted <u>online from 12am Saturday 17th December until 12pm Monday 26th</u> <u>December</u> with a penalty rate of 50% on all entry and show fees (not stabling or camping) and will not appear in the catalogue.
- 4. Additional entries will be accepted from existing competitors during the show with a 50% late entry fee. Entries to be made at the show office within office hours the day before the class(es).
- 5. Substitutions:

All Substitutions must be made in writing on the official NZNHP Substitution Form.

(Form # NZNHP SUB 2023) and lodged with the Secretary by 5.00pm the day before the scheduled class start time to avoid disruption to the smooth running of the show.

Substitution is permitted provided the horse or pony for which another entry is substituted takes no further part at the show. The substitute must be of the same grade and or class as the original entry and must be owned by the same person.

6. Scratchings:

All Scratchings must be made in writing on the official NZNHP Scratching Form (Form # NZNHP SCR 2023) and lodged with the Show Secretary **by 5.00pm the night before** the scheduled class or classes to avoid disruption to the smooth running of the show.

7. Refund of entry fees:

Refund of entry fees will be considered if application is made in writing on the official NZNHP Refund of Entries Request Form (Form # NZNHP REFUND 2023) and officially lodged with the Secretary by 5.30pm Monday 9th January 2023 prior to the start of the Show and must be accompanied by a doctor's, or vet certificate which is on official letterhead stationary and signed by the issuer. Refunds will be less 40% of the original entry fee (ground levy & stabling fees exempt), and will be at the discretion of the Show Committee. Refunds, if approved, will be paid out within 21 working days following the Show.

8. Cancellation:

In the unlikely event of the Cancellation of the show, Refunds will be less 10% of the original entry fee. Refunds will be paid out within 21 working days following the cancellation date.

- 9. The Competitor participates in the Show at their own risk.
- 10. The committee has the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving any reason for doing so; and reserves the right to make any alteration to the show timetable or withdraw any class or section as may be deemed necessary.
- 11. The committee reserves the right to replace prize money with products of equivalent value.
- 12. CURRENT RAS Height Certificate /performance cards are the responsibility of the rider/handler, and must be carried on show day at all times.
- 13. These will be checked at entry to the ring. No current certificate, No entry.
- 13. Each competitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created; or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds; or after leaving the show.
- 14. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and its amendments.
- 15. Horse and pony ID tags are to be worn at all times on covers or headcollars, except when competing.
- Prize money: will be paid out within 21 working days following the show. Please enter bank account number during online entry process.
 If <u>no Bank Account No</u> is supplied during online entry process, <u>no prizemoney payment</u> can be made.
- 17. **Policy for payment of prize money:**
 - (a) 3 or less competitors 1st prize money only will be paid
 - (b) 4 to 6 competitors, 1st & 2nd prize money will paid
 - (c) 7 or more competitors full prize money will be paid
 Prize money may be substituted with product or prize vouchers to the equivalent or higher value.
- 18. *Start times will be adhered to as closely as possible. Although it is provided that horses may compete in more than one class, all such classes may be judged simultaneously at the convenience of the judges or stewards. In all such cases where exhibitors have an exhibit entered in more than one class they must select in which class they compete.

Where an exhibitor has several Led Stock horses/ponies in different Rings at the same time, a handler must be provided for each. Rings and judging <u>WILL NOT</u> be held up. For Safety reasons, leaders of all Led Horses (over 148cm) must be a minimum of 12 years of age (as at 1st August 2022).

- 19. CLEAN SPORT: Clean Sport testing may be carried out at this Show. The administering of any drug which affects the performance of a horse or pony is forbidden. The committee reserves the right to submit any animal to veterinary examination. The Rules of the Royal A&P Society of New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the risk of the person responsible (PR). A forbidden Substance is any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central nervous system or the cardio-vascular respiratory, alimentary, digestive, muscoskeletal or urogenital systems.
- 20. Protests: Must be submitted within 20 minutes of that event's completion with a deposit of \$70.00, to be lodged at the Secretary's Office. The money will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
- 21. Entries: The Chief Steward may, at their discretion, transfer an entry to its appropriate class where it is found to be wrongly entered. Advice must be given to the Secretary's office. The committee reserves the right to split or combine classes according to entry numbers. A horse or pony entered in the Newcomer or Novice sections may also enter in the open sections.
- 22. NZ Pleasure Sections: Any combination entered in the NZ Pleasure Horse or Pony section is not permitted to enter any other ridden section of the show except the Breed sections (if eligible), and any of the Led sections. Horses and Ponies shown in the Hacks, Park Hacks, Saddle Hunters, Riding Horse, Show Pony, Saddle Hunter Pony, Lead Rein or First Ridden and Jumping sections are not permitted to be shown in the Pleasure Horse or Pony sections.
- 23. Stallions & Colts: are eligible for all classes and must be shown in a bit (except foals). They must be clearly Identified with "S" identification badges, one on each side of their bridle at all times. The rider must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. Handlers & Riders of stallions and colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest during the show when outside of the showing ring. ('S' badges, arm bands and vests can be purchased from RAS Head Office). Handlers or riders of Pony Stallions must be 14 years or over; and under 17 years if riding an open pony stallion. Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider/handler 17 years of age or over (ages as at 1st August 2022) No Stallions/Colts are to be left unattended or tied to a float/truck at any time while on the show grounds. It is compulsory for a Stallion/Colt to be accommodated in a loose box.
- 24. Parking: All competitors must park their floats and trucks in the area designated for this purpose. NO exceptions. Vehicle Passes must be displayed, and are available from the show office on arrival.
- 25. Arenas: There will be no riding, with the exception of official arena familiarisation times, in any Showing arena at any time other than when competing.
- 26. The use of audio equipment of any kind, or a communication device between the side-line and a competitor, is strictly forbidden.
- 27. A hard hat is generally described as a hunting cap, protective headwear, or a safety helmet. Wearing a Hard Hat conforming to the current AS/NZ Safety standards is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling or riding for any reason an exhibit at this show. ALL HATS MUST BE 'RED' TAGGED on the Harness NO RED TAG, NO START. From 1st August 2023 all hats must have a Yellow sticker any hat with a yellow sticker in advance of that date will be accepted.
- 28. Competitors must provide their own breast number holder and number.. Numbers to be black on white background. For Safety, Jumping competitors to wear number on left arm.
- 29. No lapels or insignia are permitted on any riding coats or numnahs when exhibiting at this show.
- 30. All pony riders must wear correct pony attire. No long boots/chaps. Novice & Newcomer Ponies (novice only) may be ridden by an adult. Open Newcomer Ponies must be ridden by a rider under 17 years.

- 31. All horses stabled on the grounds must have an ID tag on at all times when not competing. Please do not move your horse or pony without arrangement with the stabling steward. Stables will be allocated in order of paid entry. First In First Served. Stallions must be in a stallion stable.
- 32. Any paid professional trainer on the grounds must gain prior permission from the committee before giving tuition.
- 33 Any horse or pony that leaves the Ring during a class without being asked to do so, will be eliminated from the class.
- 34. **The disposal of the contents of portable toilets into ANY rubbish bin or skip bin is Prohibited** and any person caught or found doing so will be eliminated from the Competition and asked to leave the showgrounds.
- 35. Yellow card This Show/Event supports the RAS "Yellow Card" system, and it will be used at this show if necessary.

Unacceptable behaviour towards other competitors, stewards, judges and officials, will not be tolerated.

A yellow card will be issued for offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card, (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website – <u>www.ras.org.nz</u>.

- 36. Arrears No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, sponsorship or any other debt is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event until paid in full. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.
- 37 Summary of RAS Resolution Process the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show.
 If the matter is in regard to a RAS official, the show will request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with it in an appropriate manner.
- Stabling:- Clean sawdust will be provided for ALL competitors.
 Each competitor is asked to consider others when filling their stables.

<u>ALL stables, yards and parking areas are to be left in a clean and tidy condition</u>, with all manure and leftover hay and feed placed in the appropriate bins or removed. ALL stables and yards will be checked at the end of the show and **those requiring cleaning will be charged a \$50 fee.**

This will be deducted from your prize money payment or charged to you following the show.

Covered horse accommodation will be allocated to entries paid in full on a 'first in first served' basis.

39. Health & Safety Specific Requirements:

• Motorbikes of any type (Quads, 2 or 3 – wheelers) are not allowed on the grounds during the show.

"From 1 January 2022, the trimming of a horse/pony's whiskers, eye and inner ear hair is banned for any horses/ponies exhibiting or competing at affiliated A&P Shows or Kindred Events"

This brings the RAS into line with the FEI, ESNZ and NZPCA who have applied this rule for some time. *(Information pamphlet available from the show office or RAS Head Office)*

NB: You will be asked to leave the Ring and/or will not be judged if it is deemed that the Inner Ear, Eyes, and/or Whiskers of your Exhibit have been trimmed.*


