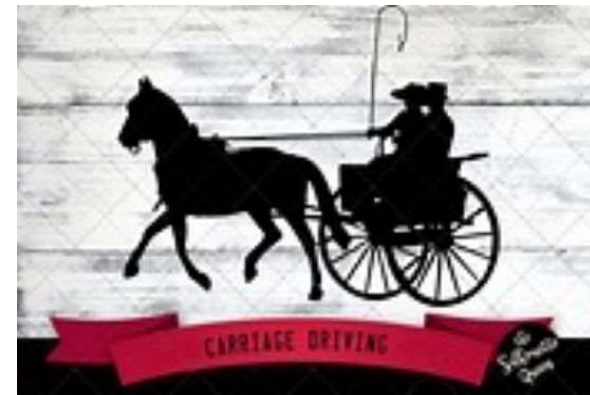

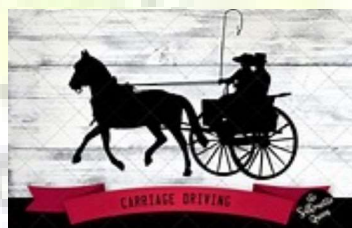

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ALL EXHIBITORS (Please read carefully)

1. No Exhibits to be removed from the Hall before 3.30 p.m. on Saturday.
1. Only stewards are allowed in the Hall whilst judging is in progress.
2. For general regulations, refer to Main Show Schedule.
3. Entry Fee = \$2.00 per entry excluding Young Persons/Teenage Section whose entry is 0.50 Cents per entry.
4. All entries to be to the Home Industries Building, Tauranga Race-course Oval, by 4.00 p.m. on FRIDAY 17TH February 2023.
PRIZE MONEY = First \$10.00, Second \$7.00, Third \$5.00, except where sponsored.
5. All vouchers to be used during year of issue. Some vouchers may have valid dates on. All prize money to be paid out using internet banking the week following the show.
6. No tied placings – see (7) below
7. In the event of a ties for any points prize, the competitor gaining the most number for first Prizes takes the trophy. If still a tie, then the greatest number of second prizes, and so on.
8. Stewards to be given power to advise the Judge to give a First, Second and Third Prize instead of only one prize where there are, in the Judge's opinion, other entries that do not qualify for prizes.
9. Any article that has taken a First Prize in any previous Tauranga A & P Show is not eligible for Entry to the same, or any other class.
10. All entries must have been completed within the last 12 months
11. Entries must be wholly the exhibitor's own work, and this must be certified by the exhibitor on the entry forms. Exhibitors must place their name on each article.

12. Exhibits may be washed, but not starched unless a crochet article which may be stiffened, but DO not attach entry to any backing whatsoever.
13. Names of winners may be used for publication in news
14. Please have in an envelope, your items correct class numbers, entry form, correct entry fee and your name & address
-VERY IMPORTANT -
15. NO professional persons who sell the products or ware can enter.
16. No cash change given when presenting vouchers.
17. If nobody has entered a particular class, the Committee reserves the right to give gift prizes
18. for First and Second placings in another if surplus of prizes is left.
