RAS In-Line Resolution Policy Process:

A Yellow or Red Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution & the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand & their grounds & their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow or Red Warning. LIABILITY

The Organising Committee accepts no liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to ponies, horses, owners, riders, handlers, grooms or spectators, or to any other personal property whatsoever.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the venue. North Island Premier Showing Championships or Kihikihi Domain take no responsibility for injury or loss to competitor, horse or gear.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the At Work Act 2015 & any amendments.

GENERAL

- Dogs ARE allowed but must be kept on a leash at all times.
- RIDDEN STALLIONS are welcomed to compete at North Island Premier Showing Championships (NIPSC), RAS Colt/Stallion rules MUST be adhered to. Due to no stallion yards/stables, there are no stallions to be kept on the grounds overnight.
- If a horse or pony misbehaves to the extent that it unduly disturbs other competitors, it will be asked to leave the ring immediately by the ring steward or judge.
- Horses/Ponies 3 Years and Under are not to be ridden
- Age of Riders/Handlers are as at 1 August 2023
- The committee reserves the right to amalgamate or split classes depending upon number of entries received.
- Novice ponies may be ridden by a rider over 17rs in the Novice Pony section only, NOT in OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES.
- Competitors in the JUNIOR RIDER section at the NIPSC may ride a horse over 148cm, but they must present for judging in SHORT JODPHUR BOOTS. Competitors presenting in long boots or chaps/gaiters will be asked to leave the class prior to judging.
- NO tying to trucks or floats, all horses or ponies MUST be kept in a yard - These MUST be booked with entries.
- ALL competitors must park their floats and trucks in the area designated for this purpose.
- Number holders are compulsory - Competitors to supply their own numbers.
- PROTEST: All objections or protests must be lodged within an hour of the class accompanied with a \$100 fee to the head steward. Official protest forms are available at the show office.
- The attention of the exhibitors is particularly drawn to the RAS CLEAN SPORT conditions relating to the misuse of drugs and the intention of the committee to undertake testing for forbidden substances. Your signature on the entry form and/or participation in the competition denotes your acceptance of these conditions.

ENTRIES

- Entries will be through www.evoevents.co.nz
- Entries close 5pm Sunday 7th January 2024 - **NO LATE ENTRIES PAST THIS DATE.**
- Additional entries for a horse/pony already entered will be accepted without late fee.

- All entries and other fees to be paid in full at time of entry or entry will not be accepted.
- This is a RAS HOY qualifying Show.
- A current height/performance certificate for every horse or pony must be carried and made available to the steward or show organisers on request.
- The definition of novice – classes for horses or ponies that have yet to win 6 classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A&P show/event. They may have competed in the open section.
- Scratching's – refund for all classes and other fees less 25%. Subject to proof of inability to compete (Vet or Doctors certificate). Subject to conditions and refund form being completed within 7 days of the event.
- The committee reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entry or refund without adjudicating any reason for doing so.
- Prize Money may be substituted for prizes at the discretion of the show committee.
- ALL Novice Challenge combinations must enter and compete in 2 other classes at the 2024 N.I Premier Show. One of these classes must be a Novice Height Class. Failure to participate in 2 classes will result in forfeit of all prize money and awards won in the Novice Challenge.
- ALL Open Challenge combinations must enter and compete in 2 other classes at the 2024 N.I Premier Show. One of these classes must be a Open Height Class. Failure to participate in 2 classes will result in forfeit of all prize money and awards won in the Open Challenge.
- Substitutions of any entry can only be made at the discretion of the show committee. Please submit your substitution to the Show Secretary.

YARDING & CAMPING

- Yarding Fee \$20 PER HORSE/PONY for entire show - THIS IS COMPULSORY FOR ALL HORSES & PONIES as there is to be no tying to trucks or floats.
- Yarding will not be allocated, there is plenty for everyone so pick any yard that takes your fancy.
- Last time we had the show at Kihikihi it was a mammoth task for our VERY small committee cleaning up everyone's dirty yards. Please put manure in the trailers/skips provided not around trees etc as we must pick this all up.

LEAD REIN

In this section, the judging criteria is 60% suitability, temperament and safeness, and 40% conformation and paces.

Riders in this section may not enter any other section, unless in a Lead Rein class(s) in a Breed section. Riders must be under eight (8) years of age, with a minimum age of four (4) years to compete in the RAS classes. Rider age as at 1 August 2023. Ponies to be led by a leader/attendant (14 years and over) with the lead rein attached to the cavesson noseband of a snaffle bridle. Ponies will be asked to walk and trot – no cantering under any circumstances. Running or bearing reins or similar tackle are not allowed.
