This document gives you a summary of some useful resources on the <u>VNZ website</u>.

- You'll find free or low-cost training, either online or in person, on VNZ website's <u>Regional Training Page</u>. Training is aimed at those keen to learn more about the community and voluntary sector, and often includes topics on volunteer management. Recordings of previous VNZ webinars on various topics are available <u>here</u>.
- Every two years, VNZ releases a research report on the <u>State of Volunteering in New Zealand</u>. These reports provide valuable insights into the health, trends and issues of the voluntary sector. They can help volunteers and volunteer-involving organisations see how they fit into the sector as a whole, and provide useful learnings to help improve volunteer management.

- On the <u>VNZ blog</u>, you'll find useful articles about the community and voluntary sector.
- VNZ is running a free monthly online <u>Ako Kōtui Networking Series</u> for managers of volunteers.
 This series is a great opportunity to connect with others in the sector, share experiences and learn new approaches in volunteer management. The next session, on 27 April, is on 'Recognition of Volunteers' where we'll hear from six organisations and how they recognise their volunteers.
