- This Show/Event supports the RAS 'In-Line Resolution Process' Policy AND Clean Sport Rules AND Arrears Policy
- **Entries Close: Monday 5pm, November 10th 2025**
- Entries MUST be entered under the name of the owner of the animal or lessee name if the lease has been registered with the RAS.
- After close of entries, if there are less than five (5) animals and/or three (3) exhibitors entered in the classes/sections, Nelson A&P Association may choose to amalgamate classes/sections as necessary.
- Entry Fees must be paid at close of entries. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Equestrian Administration team.
- Class changes and substitutions are at the discretion of the Equestrian Administration team unless a Vet Certificate is provided.
- No credit refunds will be given for class changes & substitutions made in the week before the Show.
- In the event that a horse is scratched & a current Vet Certificate is provided or a rider is unable to compete & a current Medical Certificate is provided - a refund of all fees will be given minus the Equestrian & Admin Levy & the cost of any tickets issued (ticket fees will be refunded if you do not live in the Nelson/Tasman Region).
- No Class will be held for late entrants or those that have entered multiple rings.
- Whisker and ear Trimming: refer to rules - <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/whisker-and-inner-ear-trimming/>
- Helmet Tags- YELLOW: refer to rules - <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/health-and-safety/>
- Fall of a Rider - If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.
- Ages: Riders/Handlers/Ponies/Horses are as at 1 August 2025. Horses/Ponies 3 years and under are not to be ridden.
- Stables/Yards are \$20 per night & you must clean them after you have finished using them. A cleaning fee will be charged if this is not done.
- Entry to the Show is through Gum Gate or if arriving on Friday the main gate – Washbourn Gates can be used. If you need to enter through Redwood Gate contact advertising@richmondpark.nz for the stable gate code.
- Entry Tickets are required for admission to the Show by all participants & supporters on both Saturday & Sunday. Adult tickets for Non A&P Members are \$10.00 per person.
- Photographs/copies of current height certificates must be provided to the office with entry forms when entering into sections/classes requiring these. **Originals of the certificates must be presented for all height stipulated classes, including any Breed Section classes on entering the ring.**
- **PLEASE NB: Since 2024, due to damage to some of our older trophies & to bring us into line with other shows, NO trophies will be allowed to be taken home by winners. Time will be allowed for photographs to be taken with the trophy on the day that it is awarded but they must be handed back to the stewards.**

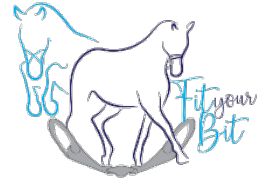
