Entries for Equestrian are accepted through the Main Events website. Fax or email entries will not be accepted.

If any competitor finds that their entry has been left out of the catalogue, please see the Equestrian Secretary at the A&P Show Office for verification and a note for the Steward.

Jumping Horse or Pony Registration Options:

- NOT registered with ESNZ at all → Pay \$30.15 Flexi-Start (includes \$25 fee + \$5.15 admin).
- Registered with ESNZ (but not for Jumping/Show Hunter) → Pay \$25 Flexi-Start.
- Registered for Jumping/Show Hunter with ESNZ → No Flexi-Start fee needed.

Note: Horses can only jump up to 1.10m and ponies up to 1.00m on a Flexi-Start.

These horses/ponies cannot enter Series Classes or earn HOY points in Show Hunter.

Jumping Rider Membership Options:

- Casual Rider Membership → \$16.30 per event.
- Introductory Membership or Day Start → \$16.30 per day (for INTRO classes only).

Jumping Intro/Day Start Riders may only compete in:

- 80cm and under (Ponies)
- 90cm and under (Horses)

They must upgrade to Full ESNZ Membership to enter higher classes or Series classes.

Results are not recorded with ESNZ for Intro/Day Start entries.

PRIZES IN ALL SECTIONS

Prize money will be paid by direct credit to your nominated bank account within 2 weeks of the show. All prize money is GST inclusive.

Showing Section:

- 1-3 entries 1st placing only.
- 4-6 entries, 1st and 2nd placing only.
- 7+ entries 1st to 3rd.

Showjumping:

- ENZ Series Classes 1st to 6th.
- Open Classes 1st to 3rd prize money and ribbons to 4th.
- Over 21 entries 1:7 ration prize money.
- Intro A1 Classes ribbons only
- A1 Open Classes prize money and ribbons.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the CHB A & P Association is \$40 per year (incl GST). Membership can be included with your entry fees. This entitles a member to a car pass to the members' car park, and 2 Adult passes.

LATE ENTRIES

Please note that all late entries will be charged 50% extra with no exceptions. Late entries may not appear in the catalogue and cannot be guaranteed a yard on the grounds.

SUBSTITUTIONS

The substitute must be of the same height class as the original entry.

The Association reserves the right to substitute trophies in lieu of cash prizes or vice versa at their discretion, and the Committee, whose decision is final, shall settle any dispute in connection with private prizes.

REFUNDS AND SCRATCHINGS

The Association will refund 80% of entry fees when scratching or withdrawals occur prior to the show. From 5pm onwards on Wednesday prior to the show it will be a 50% scratching fee, should the competitor or exhibitor apply.

No veterinary or doctor's certificate is needed but a valid explanation is required.

Refunds will be paid out after the show. No refunds under \$10.00.

HORSE/PONY ACCOMMODATION

Show grounds yards for duration of show will be allocated at the time of entry only @ \$15.00 per yard. State on entry form if required. Complete ALL sections. Payment must be made with entries.

Stallions requiring a yard or box overnight are to be accommodated at the racecourse.

Accommodation is available at the racecourse for \$20.00 per box or \$15 per yard per night.

Local competitors from Central Hawke's Bay will NOT be allocated horse accommodation during the show.

The list of allocated yards will be displayed at the entry gates. You are only entitled to yards on the grounds before the main horse parking area if you are camping here. The yards are allocated to you by the Yarding Steward so please do not make any changes without authorisation. Late entries will be placed on the waiting

list for yards.

TEMPORARY YARDS OR PENS BESIDE TRUCKS OR FLOATS OR ELSEWHERE ON THE GROUNDS ARE TOTALLY PROHIBITED.

STALLIONS

NO STALLIONS ARE ABLE TO COMPETE IN RIDDEN PONY SHOWING CLASSES.

It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle at all Shows/Events at all times.

The rider/handler must also wear two (2) RAS official armbands (one for each arm) when in the ring.

Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved official armbands (one for each arm) when in the ring and Hi Viz vest when outside the showing/jumping ring.

HEIGHT CERTIFICATES

RAS HEIGHT CERTIFICATES/NOVICE PERFORMANCE CARDS MUST BE CARRIED AT ALL TIMES AND PRESENTED ON REQUEST. NO CARD – NO START – NO EXCEPTIONS.

MEASURING RULES (excerpts taken from RAS rules)

The Measuring Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (R.A.S.) will apply at this show.

Life Certificates

No Life Certificate will be issued until an animal is eight years and over has been suitably branded/microchipped. Life Certificates will not be issued on show days.

Annual Certificates

These Certificates will be valid from 1 August 2025 until 31st July 2026.

Measuring guidelines

Height certificates will only be accepted if the measurement has been made on a standard Metcalfe Measuring Stand and signed by the official measuring stewards of the R.A.S.

0.5cm will be allowed for shoes.

All horses/ponies must be presented in a bridle with a bit for measuring.

NOVICE HORSES AND PONIES

Novice ponies may be ridden by a rider of any age in novice pony classes only.

A novice exhibit or rider is one that has yet to win six (6) classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A&P Show/Event. i.e.: If you have 0, 1 or 2 wins – you can enter the 0-2 wins class. If you have 0, 1, 2 or 3 wins – you can enter the 0-3 wins class. If you have 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 wins – you can enter the 0-5 wins class. Once you have achieved 6 wins in Conformation (and this includes Ladys & Gents classes) and/or Paced & Mannered, you can no longer enter in Novice classes in that category.

All wins within each division must be recorded on the RAS Performance Measuring Card and these must be signed off by the Ring Steward on obtaining the win.

Should a novice horse win an open conformation class e.g. 'Ladys' and Gents' classes, and in height division classes, these wins must also be recorded.

The number of novice wins is to be counted at the time of the show, not the time of entry.

If a novice entry has gained the permitted number of wins by the day of the show, the competitor must advise the Equestrian Secretary and change to an open class, or if no class remains to enter a refund will be actioned after the show.

SADDLERY & ACCESSORIES

The following are not allowed when horses or ponies are being ridden on the grounds at affiliated

shows/events, nor shall a rider be lunged on a Horse or Pony with any of the following equipment attached to a bridle: Nosebands other than cavesons combined with Double Bridles or Rugby Pelhams, attachments to the curb rein of a Double Bridle, or running reins used in conjunction with Double Bridles or other curb bits, Market Harborough, Bearing reins, Tie Downs, Gags, Side Reins, or any other equipment not specifically listed here that could force or tie a horse or pony into a frame, and thereby be deemed cruel or come under the mistreatment rule – GR6.

COMPETITOR NUMBERS

COMPETITOR NUMBERS WILL BE COMPULSORY FOR THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS: Horse Saddle Hunters, Pony Saddle Hunters, Park Hack/Hack, Riding Horse, Pintos, Pleasure Horse, Pleasure Pony and Showing pony classes on the flat.

The competitor numbers will be allocated when your entry is processed but it is your responsibility to provide the number and number holder.

Competitors will not be allowed into the ring unless wearing their number.

Numbers are not required for ESNZ Show jumping classes.

Champions and Junior Champions two points extra; Reserve Champion, one point extra. In the event of no competition, only half points awarded. Competition means two or more exhibitors, whose exhibits are judged, competing for the prize or prizes in the particular class for which prizes are awarded. Ties to count one win each.

GENERAL INFORMATION

EACH EXHIBITOR MUST SUPERVISE AND CONTROL THEIR ANIMALS AT ALL TIMES AND SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY HAZARDS CREATED OR ACCIDENT, ILLNESS OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE ACTION OF THEMSELVES OR THEIR ANIMALS AT THE SHOW GROUNDS. EXHIBITORS MUST COMPLY WITH THE APPROPRIATE ANIMAL LEGISLATION AND THE HEALTH & SAFETY AT WORK ACT 2015. COMPETITORS, EXHIBITORS AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ENTER THE GROUNDS AT THEIR OWN RISK.

The CHB A & P Association is required to conform to the Health & Safety At Work Act 2015 and any amendments. However, as a Show Exhibitor at this venue you are also obligated to accept responsibilities in relation to the operation and use of our "Place of Employment: within the focus of this Act which is to eliminate, isolate or minimise risk to Personal Health and Safety. The CHB A & P Association is responsible to present a safe venue for use. As a user of these facilities you are required to take all practical measures to manage and supervise the health and safety of your event or exhibit representatives, agents, employees and servicing contractors, during the period of this event, (Including set up and disassembly). The Act embodies a considerable measure of sound common sense, with the key to identify potential risks in advance by practical management application. Some obvious elements to note as potential hazards include: leading livestock in public areas; use of machinery, tools and equipment; unstable stages, platforms and ramps; riding horses in public areas.

CLEAN SPORT

Clean Sport rules of the Royal Agriculture Society apply, a copy of which is held in the office or the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. Competitors are advised that there may be random tests for forbidden substances. Any competitor who has administered to his/her horse or pony any forbidden substance during the 7 days prior to the show, is required to notify the Equestrian Secretary before competing. The administering of any

drug which affects the performance of a horse or pony is forbidden. The Committee reserves the right to submit any animal to veterinary examination.

PROTESTS AND OBJECTIONS

Standard by-laws and regulations must be read before a formal protest is made. A full copy of these rules and regulations will be available at the Equestrian Secretary's office or upon request. The charge per protest is \$50.00

LIQUOR BAN AREA

Please be aware that the show grounds are in a liquor ban area and alcohol is banned apart from the designated areas determined on the special licence. Please be responsible and do not ruin things for other people.

GR 8. FALL OF RIDER If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.

Age of Riders/Handlers/Ponies/Horses are as at 1 August 2025. Ponies/Horses 3 years and under must not be ridden.

The committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the show timetable or to postpone/cancel the show or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable.
