

### **ENTRIES**

- Stratford A&P Show is run under the rules and regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society & Equestrian Sports NZ.
- Entries close Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025, to be recognized in the catalogue.
- Enter online at [www.main-events.com](http://www.main-events.com)
- Entry fee is \$12 per horse per class; GST Inclusive, unless stated.
- Change of class on the day will be accommodated where possible. An additional fee of \$3 per horse per entry will be charged.
- After close off of entries, if there are less than five (5) animals and/or three (3) exhibitors entered in the classes/sections, the Committee may then amalgamate classes/sections as necessary.

### **ENTRY CONDITIONS**

- Run under the Rules and Regulations of the RAS and/or local conditions designated below.
- All jumping classes run under ESNZ rules current at the time of the Show.
- All riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership.
- Entries are submitted subject to the rules and regulations of the Association.
- All persons attend and compete at their own risk.
- Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.
- Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal Legislation and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments thereafter.
- Entry in the Show entitles the Stratford A&P Association to publish an Exhibitor name, photos and videos including livestock and will publish these for the purpose of media reports or promotion.
- The use of Prefixes on Horses and Ponies in the Showing Classes at A&P Shows be those of the Breeder.
- The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for doing so.
- Exhibitors must check their entry form carefully. A confirmation of entries will be sent, it is the competitors responsibility to check the details are correct.
- Once entries are catalogued, changes can be made but will not be reflected in the Catalogue.
- The Stewards retain the right to change the order of, alter or delete classes dependent on entries.
- Starting Times are approximate only, but will be adhered to as closely as possible. Although it is provided that horses may compete in more than one class, any or all of such classes may be judged simultaneously at the convenience of the Judges or Stewards. In all such cases exhibitors having an exhibit entered in more than one class must elect in which class they compete. Allowance may be made if necessary for competitors appearing out of order, but the Steward's decision will be final. No responsibility will be taken for any competitor missing classes.
- Any horse showing signs of ill health may be refused entry, at the discretion of the Horse Section Steward.
- It is an offence for any electronic or audio equipment carried on a competitor in the show ring, deemed to be possible of outside assistance to a competitor. Penalties may include forfeiting all prize money, awards and qualifications and elimination from any further classes at that show.
  - The Horse/Pony competing for Champion, Reserve Champion must be ridden by the rider who qualified the Horse/Pony or have had dispensation from the Chief Horse Steward to substitute the rider.
  - Exhibitors are requested to place all horse manure in bins as supplied
  - Dogs MUST be on a lead at all times

### **PRIZE MONEY**

- All prize money will be paid out after the show into a nominated bank account, please enter details on the entry form. This will be done (subject to any queries) within 30 days of the final show day.
- Prize money will be withheld if height certificate is not supplied on show day and will not be paid at all if height certificate is not supplied within 21 days.
- Sponsors product may be given as well as or instead of prize money. Prize money shown is inclusive of GST.

### **STRATFORD A&P GROUND FEE**

- A ground fee of \$5.00 per horse/pony applies and is payable on entry.

### **EXHIBITOR GATE PASSES**

- Exhibitors who enter by 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025 will be posted tickets which admits 1 person and 1 vehicle with animals. If enter late, no gate pass will be issued.

## **PARKING**

- Exhibitors will be allocated parking area on arrival at the grounds and MUST follow instructions of Parking Stewards at all times. Refusal to do so will result in Competitor being asked to leave the grounds.

## **COMPETITOR NUMBERS**

- Numbers will be provided and must be worn in all classes in the oval and breed sections. There are armbands provided in all competitor packs which are to be worn on the left arm, if not using a shield number holder and in the working hunter classes.
- Armbands not returned at the end of competition will result in a charge of \$5 being deducted from prize money or will be invoiced accordingly.
- All Horses must be identified at all times from time of arrival. ID Tags when horses are not being schooled or competed must show the name of rider or the person responsible and a contact phone number at the event.

## **HORSE ACCOMODATION**

- No temporary pens (tape or other) to be erected on the grounds.
- Horse Stables/Covered Yards - \$15 each per night, Open Pens \$6 each per night, payable with entry fees.
- We will endeavor to meet everyone's stabling requests; stable and covered yard preference will be given to those out of the area and in the order entries are received. We will endeavor to advise as early as possible if your first stabling choice is unable to be given.
- Any horse found to be in stable/yard will be removed and the exhibitor charged \$50.00 per horse.
- Straw is not to be used in stables.
- At the conclusion of the show each exhibitor using a stable/yard must muck it out and leave it free of rubbish. Hay and Muck must be put in Muck Bins. A cleaning fee of \$50.00 per horse will be charged for stables not mucked out.

## **RAS EQUESTRIAN RULES**

- The RAS Equestrian Rulebook for RAS Affiliated Shows/Events, Competitors, Exhibitors and Judges (see [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz)) sets out all the conditions that apply to the classes and sections offered, each Equestrian Breed that is affiliated to the RAS offer their own standard schedule of classes and any additional rules that apply to showing their particular breed.

## **RAS EQUESTRIAN LEVY**

- The RAS Equestrian levy of \$1.25 per class on each horse/pony entry at the Show, is included in the class fee.

## **RAS In-Line Resolution Process - Protests / Behaviour & Conduct / Complaint**

- In-Line RAS Resolution Process will be followed for all inappropriate behavior by exhibitor, competitor, member, official, spectator; exhibitor competitor rule breakage, animal abuse etc.
- The sanctions of YELLOW CARD for warning and RED CARD for penalty/expulsion will be used.
- Every objection or protest must be made in writing, signed by the person making such complaint, and delivered to the Show Secretary.
- The RAS 'In-Line Resolution Process' policy is available to view on the RAS website [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz) .

## **CLEAN SPORT**

- The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply.
- Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk.
- Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.
- From 1 January 2022, the trimming of a horse/pony's whiskers, eye and inner ear hair is banned for any horses/ponies exhibiting or competing at affiliated A&P Shows or Kindred Events. - <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/whisker-and-inner-ear-trimming/>

## **ARREARS**

- No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

## **HATS & SAFETY HELMETS**

- All riders, including harness drivers/with the exclusion of heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes, competing at RAS affiliated A & P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds or the grounds of an affiliated Event.
- Hats/helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards. These standards may be subject to change but the latest list can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz-equestrian>. RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook.

- All hats/helmets that conform as per above must be identified by the current tag system implemented by NZPCA, ESNZ and RAS. Please note: As from 1 August 2023, new standards where a 'yellow' tag must be shown. <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/health-and-safety/>
- The use of cameras by riders while riding at the showgrounds is prohibited, unless specifically agreed by officials.
- Motorbikes are permitted inside the security fence in the stables area only and may only be ridden by licensed drivers with helmets. A strict speed limit of 10km/h applies.

#### **FALL OF RIDER**

- If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.

#### **STRATCHINGS/REFUNDS**

- Application for refunds must be in writing, accompanied by a Doctors/Veterinary Certificate, and will be made after the show at the committee's discretion, maximum refunds to be 75% of entry fee.

#### **RAS CERTIFICATE**

- A current RAS issued Annual or Life Height Certificate must be carried at all times at this show.

#### **STALLIONS & COLTS**

- All stallions and colts must be shown in a bit with the exception of Foals and Miniature Horses, and Shetland Pony Yearlings. In the case of Miniature Donkey Jacks 86cm and under, they must either be shown in a bit or a halter with a stallion chain. If utilizing the option of a halter and a stallion chain, then the donkey's original RAS height certificate must be carried at the time of showing, to show proof of height.
- A Steward will order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor.
- It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times.
- The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS Head Office.
- Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi-Vis vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring. Vests can be purchased from RAS Head Office.

#### **BROODMARES**

- Mares shown in Brood Mare Classes must have a foal at foot or present a veterinary certificate of pregnancy that includes a projected foaling date.

#### **AGE OF RIDERS & HANDLERS**

- Rider/Handler's age and eligibility is determined as per the 1 August i.e. Riders/handlers who are of age for any division/section on the 1 August complete the show year/ season in that division/section. Proof of age may be required and should be on hand.
- Lead Rein classes are restricted to riders under eight (8) years of age with a minimum age of four (4) years, who are not competing in any other sections at any A&P Show/Event. To be led by an attendant fourteen (14) years of age or over.
- First Ridden classes are restricted to riders under ten (10) years of age, who are not competing in any other sections at any A&P Show/Event.
- Novice pony exhibits (except Novice Pony Stallions) may be ridden by a rider of any age, in novice pony classes only.
- Novice pony stallions must be led or ridden by a rider fourteen (14) years and over.
- Open pony exhibits must be ridden by riders under seventeen (17) years of age.
- Open pony stallions must be ridden by a rider fourteen (14), or fifteen (15), or sixteen (16) years of age, led handlers must be fourteen (14) years and over.
- Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be twelve (12) years and over.
- Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider seventeen (17) years of age or older.

#### **AGE OF RIDDEN EXHIBITS**

- Exhibits three (3) years and under of age are not permitted in any ridden or driven (harness) class no matter what the rules of any affiliated Breed Society or Kindred Society may prescribe.

#### **ESNZ LEVIES**

- Compulsory and payable by all horses/ponies competing in ESNZ Show Hunter.

- All riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate membership and pay the appropriate jumping fees, see the ESNZ website for registration information.
- All classes run under ESNZ rules. Show Hunter rules can be downloaded from [www.nzequestrian.org.nz](http://www.nzequestrian.org.nz)
- Riders must be full ESNZ members

- Equine Registration Requirements and Rider Membership for National Series & Equitation Series classes – Full ESNZ rider Membership and equine ESNZ registration PLUS \$25 per event OR ESNZ Casual Equine Registration \$30.15 includes Discipline Flexi-start \$25 plus Discipline Levy \$8.50 per event.
- Pony riders must carry a current RAS height certificate.
- Ponies are NOT restricted to one category BUT are only eligible to win the championship they are eligible for by height: Ponies 133cm & under Cat A, Ponies over 133cm & up to & including 143cm Cat B, and Ponies over 143cm & up to & including 148cm Cat C
- For Pony National Series classes 952, 956, 961 riders must enter the correct category for the height of their pony - Ponies 133cm & under must enter Cat A pony National Series (class 961)- Ponies over 133cm & up to & including 143cm must enter Cat B National Series (class 956)- Ponies over 143cm & up to & including 148cm must enter Cat C National Series (class 952)




