RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Our Show is run under RAS rules. An electronic version of the RAS Equestrian Rule book at the following link:

Please familiarize yourself with the rules and kindly abide by them.

All exhibitors agree to comply with the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 and its subsequent amendments. South Island Premier Show will not accept any responsibility in any claim from a person resulting from non-compliance with the Act. All Exhibitors and Competitors must follow the instructions of the Stewards and Officials. Exhibitors and Competitors are responsible for ensuring horses are kept in control of any horse is considered dangerous, unruly or unmanageable. All exhibits shall be at the sole risk of the owner or exhibitor and South Island Premier Show shall not, under any circumstances, be responsible for loss or damage, mis-delivery, detention or delay of exhibits of any description whatsoever.

The South Island Premier Show Committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to, or suffered by any exhibit, person or property and it shall be a condition that the signing of the entry form, that each exhibitor shall hold the Committee indemnified against any claim.

Entries -

- No entry will be considered valid unless the entry form has been completed in full.
- Entries will be returned if the compulsory fees are not paid.
- Arrears - No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted
- The Show Committee reserve the right to alter, change or combine classes.
- Entry Fees and Fees must accompany entries. There will be no refund of entry fees under any circumstances except on presentation of a Doctors/Veterinary Certificate to be produced before or within 7 days of the day of show – 50% of entries will be refunded.
- No refunds under \$20 will be made
- Substitution of any entry can only be made at the discretion of the Show/Committee.
- The Show/Event reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry.
- The name of the entered exhibit must be the same name as on the RAS Certificate (Annual or Life). If sponsorship is secured and the name of the sponsor is required to be added to the exhibit's name, an application must be made to the RAS Head Office for a replacement certificate.

Breed classes - registration numbers must be stated at the time of entry.

Judging - All times listed in the schedule/catalogue are approximate, please be ready for your class.

SI Premier Championship "Titles" for respective sections will be judged by 3 Judges and awarded prize money & awards as per index.

Exhibitors must be ready to enter the ring when the class is called. Classes will not be held up if you have entered more than one section.

Exhibitors must carry a current official RAS Life or Horse/Pony annual height and performance card for RAS and HOY Qualifying sections, failure to do so will result in elimination.

Protests - must be in writing, and lodged, with the Secretary either before or after the Judges have proceeded to their duties. Any exhibitor entering a protest must deposit \$100, which will be forfeited if the protest is not successful. If the protest is lodged before the Judges proceed to their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the exhibitor. If after that the onus of proof will be with the party protesting. No protest will be received later than half an hour after the prizes are awarded. The Committee will decide all protests as soon as practicable, and there should be no appeal from their decision.

No competitor/exhibitor or member of their family shall approach a judge in regard to a decision unless they first obtain the permission of the Show's Steward, Secretary or President.

In-Line Resolution Process Policy - This Show/Event supports the RAS In-Lines Resolution Process Policy. A Yellow or Red Card will be issued, In cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow or Red Card. Full wording of the 'Policy is available to view on the RAS website - www.ras.org.nz

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal Agricultural A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Forbidden Substance - "any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardiovascular, respiratory, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems."

Stallions - Stallions may enter at the Committee's discretion. All Stallions & Colts (with the exception of Miniature horses & foals) must be shown in a bit. The Steward will order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colts, owner/exhibitor/competitor/handler/rider.

It is compulsory for all stallions/colts except for foal, to wear two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all shows/events at all times. The rider must also wear two (2) RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. Riders/Handlers of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the show ring.

Saddlery and Accessories - All Riders must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than 2 points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened, anywhere within the Showgrounds. Hats/helmets must conform to the current standards and must be identified by the current tag system. Please note that as from 1 August 2023 there are new Standards, where a 'yellow' tag must be shown - <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/health-and-safety/>

Whips - in Ridden classes shall not exceed 76cm in length. Whips in Lead Rein and First Ridden sections shall not exceed 76cm including the flap which shall measure no more than 2cm wide and 4cm long.

Exhibits showing welts from whip abuse will immediately be dismissed from the ring and disqualified without further recourse for the remainder of the show.

Bearing Reins or Similar Tackle - The following are not allowed when horses or ponies are being ridden on the grounds at affiliated shows/events, nor shall a rider be lunged on a Horse or Pony with any of the following equipment attached to the bridle. Nosebands other than cavesons combined with Double Bridles or Rugby Pelhams, attachments to the curb rein of a Double bridle, or running reins used in conjunction with Double bridles or other curb bits, Market Harborough, Bearing reins, Tie downs, Gags, Side reins or any other equipment not specifically listed here that could force or tie a horse or pony into a frame, and thereby be deemed cruel or come under the mistreatment rule-GR 6.

In the interests of safety, the stirrup iron and the stirrup leather must hang freely from the bar of the saddle and outside the flap. The rider must not directly or indirectly tie any part of their body to the saddlery, unless it is stated otherwise on a current RAS issued competitor's/exhibitor's disability card.

Electronic and Audio Equipment – Any electronic or audio equipment carried on a competitor/exhibitor deemed to be possible of rendering outside assistance to a competitor is banned (unless this is stated otherwise on a current RAS issued competitor's/ exhibitor's disability card), from all competitions at any RAS or Affiliated shows/events, with the penalty of forfeiting all prize money, awards and qualifications and elimination from any further classes at the show.

Exhibitors Disability Card – An identification card is available for Exhibitors with a disability who may require accessories or aids for competing. These aids might include (but not restricted to) special tied stirrups, hearing equipment, monkey straps etc. All aids to be used must be stated explicitly on the application form and shall be transposed onto the card the rider carries at the show. An application form is available on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz

Number Holders - To be worn by either Horse or Handler. Compulsory for all classes/sections, both Led & Ridden. **No Back Numbers** will be provided. Correct Back Numbers must be displayed for each entry in the class.

Novice - A Novice exhibit or rider is one that has yet to win six (6) classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A & P Show/Event.

Note: To clarify further, at time of first day of the Show/Event competition:

- If you have 0,1 or 2 wins-you can enter the 0-2 wins class
- If you have 0,1,2 or 3 wins you can enter the 0-3 wins class
- If you have 0,1,2,3,4 or 5 wins you can enter the 0-5 wins class

Once you have achieved 6 wins in Conformation and /or Paced & Mannered classes, you can no longer enter in Novice classes in that category.

Once a 'Novice' has had six wins it is not eligible for Novice classes. If a Novice entry has gained six wins by the day of the show, the competitor must advise the Show office and may change to an Open class within the same section or if no class remains to enter, a refund will be actioned after the Show. Novice classes are open to riders of any age.

Novice Ponies/Horses are able to enter Open Riding classes & Title classes.

Novice Pony exhibits (except Novice Pony Stallions) may be ridden by a rider of any age.

- Novice Pony Stallions must be led or ridden by a fourteen (14) yrs & over.
- Open Pony exhibits must be ridden by riders under seventeen (17) yrs of age.
- Open Pony Stallions must be ridden by a rider fourteen (14) fifteen (15) or sixteen (16) yrs of age. Led Handlers must be fourteen (14) yrs & over.
- Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be twelve (12) yrs & over.
- Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a seventeen (17) yrs & over

Age of Horses/Ponies – is as at 1 August 2025. Exhibits three (3) years of age and under are not permitted in any ridden class no matter what the rules of any affiliated breed or kindred society may prescribe.

Age of Riders/Handlers - A Riders/Handlers age and eligibility is determined as per the 1st August 2025 i.e Riders/Handlers who are of age for any division/section on 1 August 2025 complete the show/year in that division/section.

Lead Rein classes are restricted to riders under eight (8) yrs of age with a minimum age four (4) yrs, who are not competing in any other section at the show. To be led by an attendant fourteen (14) yrs or over

First Ridden classes are restricted to riders under ten (10) yrs of age, who are not competing in any other sections at any A&P Show/event.

GR 8. FALL OF RIDER

If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.

Temporary Pens - Penning other than fixed permanent instalments provided by the show is banned at all RAS shows and includes but not restricted to tape, strings, ropes, chains.

Stallions and colts can only be tied to a truck or float if they are under constant supervision, or tied within an approved solid framed portable yard (see RAS website from RAS endorsed temporary pen systems that meet safety requirements) that is attached to the outside of the truck or float. Otherwise, they must be confined in stables, suitable yards or within their floats or trucks.

More than one horse can be ridden by the same rider in a SI Premier "Title" Class. These classes will have no working on the ring just an individual workout. Horses will parade at the walk at the start and/or completion of all workouts. Substitute Riders/Handlers dressed in appropriate attire may be used for prize giving presentation.

The combination (horse and rider) must have entered in a Class in a Saturday section before being eligible to enter Title Classes or Championship classes (including rider Title classes). Eligible entries assessed as at date of close of entries. ie: no late combination entries on show day.

Class changes must be made by 7pm the night before the running of a class.

Stables and Yards must be cleaned out upon leaving the show. There is to be no Smoking in or around the Stabling area. Any person found smoking in the stables may be fined \$500. Stables and yards will be allocated on a first in - first served basis. Noting that yarding is limited.

Riders please note:

The Rider age group classes on Saturday are the "HOY qualifying" classes.

Title classes on Sunday are **not** HOY qualifiers.
