Te Kauwhata A & P Show is affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand and operates under the Rules and Regulations of the RAS. www.ras.org.nz.

The 'In-Line' Resolution Process has been adopted by Te Kauwhata A&P Association. Full wording of the process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. A Yellow or Red Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations / Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show / registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the person responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. If the matter is in regard to an RAS official, the show is to forward the concern on to the RAS Operations Manager to handle in an appropriate manner.

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at risk of the person responsible.

Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

Arrears - No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted. The Association will not be responsible for any accident in competitions or that may occur from machinery or other exhibits or plants belonging to exhibitors, competitors or the Association and it is a condition of entry that such exhibitor, competitor or visitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings issuing from any accidents so caused.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments.

FALL OF RIDER FALL OF RIDER

If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.

No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Head Steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible for an exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.

No classes will be held up for competitors competing in other rings, there are no exceptions.

A judicial committee comprising the President, Secretary and Chief Steward of the section concerned will adjudicate any protests. In the event of a conflict of interest an independent alternative will be appointed.

Membership: You can pay for or renew a membership with your entry fees. Membership is \$12.00/annum.

These are the category conditions for Equestrian.

EQUESTRIAN RULES and SPECIAL CLASSES

EQUESTRIAN CONVENOR - LEIGH TAYLOR 027 4312092

All riders, including harness drivers, with the exclusion of heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds. Hats/helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards and be tagged with the current recognised red tag implemented by NZPCA, ESNZ and RAS. These standards may be subject to change but the latest list can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz> – equestrian. RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook. Please note: As from 1 August 2023 – New Standards, where a 'yellow' tag must be shown. <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/health-and-safety/>

The RAS equestrian levy is included in the Entry fee per class.

RAS Height Certificates are to be carried at all times. Entry to classes will be declined if height certificate not produced for classes requiring same.

FALL OF RIDER

If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.

AGES

All ages of Rides/Handlers and Horse/Ponies are as at 1 August of the current season.

Horses/ponies 3 years and under must not be ridden.

REFUND OF ENTRIES

If a pony or horses is entered for the show but the animal or rider through injury or illness is prevented from competing at the Show, and a Veterinary, Farrier or Doctor's certificate confirming the fact is received at the Secretary's office by 10am on Show Day, 50% of the entry fees paid are refundable. If the horse or pony competes at the Show or the respective certificates are not received with the specified time the right to receive a refund is forfeited.

ENTRY FEES & PRIZE MONEY

Te Kauwhata A&P reserve the right to exchange prize money for product when available.

Members of the Te Kauwhata A&P Association are entitled to a \$2 discount on each class entered. You can pay or renew your membership with your entry fees. Membership is \$12.00/annum.

Te Kauwhata A&P Association reserve to right to reduce prize money.

GROUND FEES

\$10 per horse to a maximum of \$30

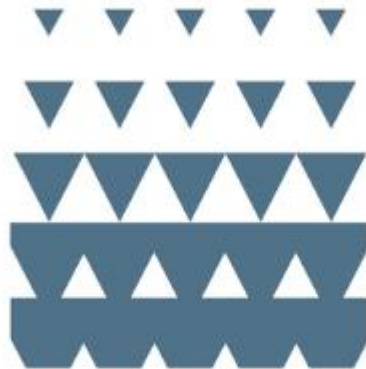

Pleasure Horse and Pony - Qualifier

Pleasure Horse/Pony means those animals who do not fit the mould of a Show Horse/Pony. We welcome any breed (e.g. Appaloosas, Quarter Horses, Standardbreds, Clyde X) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride. Whilst they do not possess the show quality conformation of a show horse, they should in their own way be a delight to ride, with impeccable manners. A "pleasure mount" is NOT an inexperienced mount with show quality conformation who is destined for the open show ring.

1. From 1 August 2015, for a horse/pony to meet the annual title show qualification requirements they must be registered with NZEPS.
2. Horses/ponies must never have been placed first in an open show ring class including working hunter. However, members may apply for dispensation to NZEPS.
3. Ordinary snaffle bit as per Dressage NZ definition only, no poll action. No bit guards, shadow rolls, ear plugs muffs or bonnets, martingales (breast plates are allowed) or tie downs
4. Bitless bridles are only permitted in Recreational pleasure classes.
5. Only cavesson nosebands are permitted no strapping below the bit .
6. Whips may be carried but must not exceed 76cms in length.
7. All riders must wear a 3 point harness helmet conforming to the current NZ Safety Standard or an equivalent standard and be yellow tagged.
8. Spurs are not to be worn.
9. Riders may be registered with other bodies.
10. Riders may have competed outside the Pleasure Horse/pony section.
11. Riders in Pony classes must be under 17yrs (proof of rider's age may be requested). Age is taken as at 1st August.
12. Children riding hacks must compete in the Horse Classes.
13. Adults may ride ponies in Horse Classes without prejudice.
14. Height certificates not required.

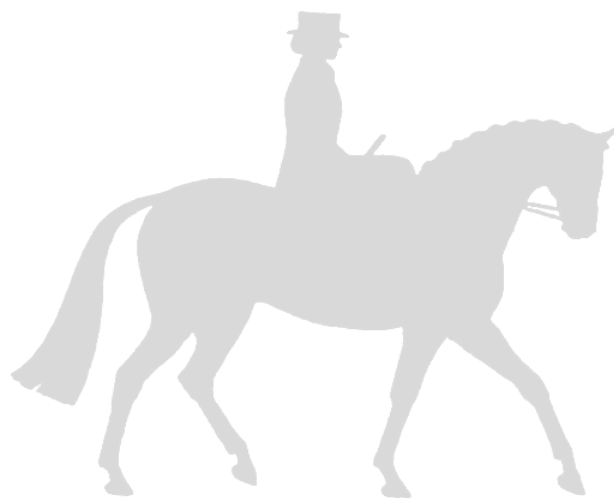
