## Tuesday 11th November 2025 Conditions of Entry

1. All entries must be completed via EvoEvents – <https://www.evoevents.co.nz/>
2. All competitors compete at own risk.
3. **GR 8. FALL OF RIDER** If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: **competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened**, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.
4. **Safety Helmets: Please abide by new ruling from RAS and ESNZ.**

5. There is to be no trimming of whiskers, eye or inner ear hair/whiskers of horses/ponies competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events. This is in line with the same animal welfare approach taken by the Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) and New Zealand Pony Clubs Association (NZPCA).

6. Age of horse, pony and rider as of 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025. Horses/ponies 3 years and under must not be ridden.
7. **Stallions and Colts:** It is compulsory for all Stallions and Colts to be shown in a bit, (except Foals, Miniature horses and Shetland yearlings), and must wear two (2) official "S" ID badges attached to each side of their bridle or halter, at all times. Handlers/Riders must wear a Hi Viz vest when outside the ring, and riders of stallions must wear 2 RAS Stallion armbands. (See Rule CDE 11 g) and i) for ages of stallion riders/handlers).
8. All competitors or legal guardians to acknowledge exhibitor declaration on entry via EvoEvents. The attention of exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to the misuse of substances, and the intention of the Committee to undertake testing for forbidden substances.
9. In-Line Resolution Process Policy. This Show supports the Policy. A Yellow or Red Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible. Full wording of the Policy is available to view on the RAS website – [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz).
10. **Clean Sport** – The Rules of the Royal A&P Society of New Zealand regarding Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible risk.  
Forbidden Substance – Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina or courage or conduct of a horse or pony by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system of the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.
11. **Arrears** – No person who is in arrears regarding entry fees, subscriptions, or any other show charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated show/event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

12. **LEGAL LIABILITY:** Our Association's Public Liability policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors. Each Exhibitor is responsible for their own Liability Insurance and must [supervise and control their animals at all times](#), Exhibitors must comply with Animal Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 and subsequent amendments.
13. **ALL DOGS** to be on leash.
14. **STABLES/YARDS** are available at the Waverley Racecourse on Monday night. **Please book via EvoEvents when you enter your classes.** All stables, yards and areas around floats & trucks must be left clean. Please place hay/sawdust/manure etc in bins designated for this.
15. **SHOW LEVY:** \$10 per mount.
16. **REFUNDS:** Requests to be made in writing and will be less 20%.
17. **NO LATE ENTRIES.** Entries to be completed via the EvoEvents site by 9pm Sunday 9th November 2025.
18. **CLASS CHANGES:** \$2.00 per class.
19. **RAS Equestrian Levy** of \$1.25 per class will be charged in addition to the class entry fee.
20. **PROTESTS:** Every objection or protest must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the Class in question, signed by the person making complaint and delivered to the Secretary. The objector shall, at the time of making such objection, lodge sum of \$50.00 which shall be forfeited to the Association should the objection be considered frivolous or vexatious. The deposit will be refunded if protest is upheld.
21. **START TIMES:** Are approximate only but will be adhered to as closely as possible.
22. Although it is provided that horses may compete in more than one class, and or all such classes may be judged simultaneously at the convenience of the judges or stewards, in all such cases where exhibitors have an exhibit entered in more than one class, they must select in which class they compete.
23. **All Show Hunter Riders, Horses and Ponies** must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership. All classes run under ESNZ rules current at the time of the show.
24. **Show Jumpers can compete in a maximum of three SJ classes.**
25. After receiving all entries, sections that have classes with no entries or insufficient entries may be cancelled or merged with another class.
26. **Due to time constraints, class entry will be capped at 15. This will be advised via Facebook.**
27. Committee reserves the right to alter the programme.


