HORSE ACCOMMODATION:

All yards will be allocated on a first in first served basis when you place your entries/prebook. Yarding is compulsory to help ensure safety on the grounds. Only open pipe and wooden yards are available for single day use.

Deluxe covered yards with sawdust \$60.00 per night (Merv Renall - limited numbers)

Covered yards with sawdust \$40.00 per night (Arcus Block or Pavilion - limited numbers)

Open pipe and wooden yards \$20.00 per night

Open pipe and wooden yards for day use only \$15

Please be aware that there is a new parking and yarding configuration. Please follow the signage and yards may not be located where they were previously. All horses and ponies in yards must wear an identifying tag with phone number. Any horses in the wrong yards will be impounded by the committee, these horses can be collected upon payment of a \$50.00 cash impound fee. \$50.00 cleaning fee applies to any stables or yards not cleaned out.

GATE ACCESS:

Entry to the Grounds is through gate 1 only. The gates will be open from midday Friday, 31 October 2025 unless prior arrangement is made with the stabling officers. Your entry fee includes 2 x general access tickets. Additional tickets may be ordered on your entry form: Adults \$20 for the show, Over 65's and Children \$10 for the show. A family pass for two adults and two children is \$40 for the show. Once you have arrived and settled in, please bring your tickets to the Horse Secretary's Office where you can get your ticket scanned and pick up your wristband. Your ticket can be scanned at any time, it doesn't have to be first thing in the morning, however you will not be able to leave and re-enter the grounds without your wristband. No person should be in the horse parking, yarding or warmup areas not wearing a wrist.

CUPS/TROPHIES:

All cups/trophies will be retained by Wairarapa A & P Society. Trophies will be available for photos and can be collected from the main office and returned after you have taken your photos etc, you will need to know the name of the trophy when collecting.

FEES:

All Sections Levy Pack: A Levy Pack of \$35.00 is payable for each horse/pony entered. This covers the ground levy, judge's levy and medical levy. Discount Pack - \$15 when a rider has 4 or more horses. Please claim the discount in the fees section of the online entry.

CAMPING ON GROUNDS:

\$10 per night, showers are available in the shower block at the MenzShed. If found to be staying on the grounds without having paid for camping, you will be disqualified from the show and asked to leave immediately.

CATALOGUE:

There will be no printed catalogues. An online version will be available on EvoEvents

ENTRIES CLOSE AT MIDNIGHT 19 OCTOBER 2025, NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE

No email entries will be accepted. Payment must accompany entries, any entries received but not paid by the closing date will be considered late. Entries will only be accepted via the EvoEvents website. Exhibitors must read the rules of ESNZ or RAS and check their entry form carefully. Entry in this show confirms that you have read and accept the rules under which our event is run and entitles the Society to publish an Exhibitors name in results and distribute with Exhibitor Lists. The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving a reason for doing so. The Society reserves the right to cancel sections and classes if there are insufficient entries.

SWAP/SCRATCH (CLASS/HORSE):

Normal entry fees will apply to swapped classes when the swap out of/into classes are nominated at the same time. Class changes must be received by the secretary by 6pm the day prior the class - no EXCEPTIONS. All swaps to be made using MY ENTRIES on EvoEvents, or at the office.

REFUNDS FOR SCRATCHING:

100% refund of entry (excluding the Admin Fee) if horse secretary is advised before midnight on the 26TH October 2025. 50% refund of entry including levies and yards if horse secretary is advised before the 30th October 2025 with a vet or doctors certificate for the horse or rider entered.

NO RIDING ON COMPETITION SURFACES unless competing.

NOVICE:

A Novice horse or pony or rider is one that has yet to win 6 show classes in any division within the competitions provided at an A & P Show. Upon achieving the sixth win in a division, a pony, horse or rider thereafter must compete in the appropriate open classes within that division. i.e. not to have won three firsts - (0-2 wins) not to have won six firsts - (0-5 wins)

Once a horse/pony/rider has three wins they are no longer eligible for the 0-2 wins class and can only go in the 0-5 wins class, once they have six wins they can no longer enter in a novice class in that section. Exhibitors must carry a current performance card for every Novice horse and make this available in the ring upon request. These must be signed by the Exhibitor or some person authorised to sign on their behalf and must be received before the closing date set.

STALLIONS:

Stallions competing must wear official stallion badges at all times and handlers/riders must wear approved armbands and 'S' Bibs. For Stallions wishing to stay on Grounds, please contact the Stabling Officer directly.

SADDLE HUNTER CLASSES:

Are open to all horses not entered in Hack, Park Hack or Riding Horse sections. Hack, Park Hack and Riding Horse sections are open to horses not entered in the Saddle hunter section. Exhibits in harness and hack classes can also compete in the driving, jumping and hunter classes where eligible.

CHAMPIONSHIP:

A horse/pony being eligible for championships must be ridden by the same rider as in the class or classes in which it

qualified unless permission of the Horse Marshal and stewards has been obtained.

MEASURING/HEIGHT CERTIFICATES:

No measuring available at this Show. Measuring will be available prior to the Show.

Exhibitors in any class with a prescribed height or where a Certificate of Height is required will be asked to show this certificate at any time. They may not leave the ring to obtain a certificate and will forfeit awards if certificate is not shown. Measuring Rules of The Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand will apply at this show.

PERFORMANCE CARDS:

Valid performance cards **MUST** be carried **AT ALL TIMES**, and produced on request of a steward, or the rider will be disqualified from competing (i.e. prize money & ribbons will be forfeited, with no refund of entry fee).

PROTESTS:

Any protests must be lodged with the Horse Marshal within half an hour of results being posted, accompanied with a \$50 fee; to be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld. All disputes will be settled by the judiciary committee consisting of the society's executive and marshal of the section.

CLEAN SPORT:

The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the responsible person's risk. Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

ARREARS:

No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted. Lists of amounts owing at 8th November will be sent to RAS, ESNZ and secretaries of future events.

RAS ON-LINE RESOLUTION PROCESS POLICY:

This Show/Event supports the RAS In-Line Resolution Process Policy. A Yellow or Red Card will be issued, In cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow or Red Card which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Policy is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz.

AGE OF RIDERS OR HORSES:

Riders age and eligibility is determined as per the 1st of August 2025. I.e. Riders/handlers who are of age for any division/section on 1st August complete the show year/season in that division/section.

Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be 12 years & over.

The age of the horse/pony is calculated as from the 1st August 2025 per ESNZ series rules

Horses/Ponies 3 years and under must not be ridden.

SADDLERY & ACCESSORIES:

Length of Whips in all classes – see <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/rule-book/> - GR 5- see

Saddlecloths are optional however it is preferred that saddlecloths used and are at least are cut to the shape of the saddle. Bearing reins, running reins or similar tack may not be used. The misuse of a whip or spurs, or the committing of an act of cruelty by an exhibitor to his horse or pony within the limits of the showground, including rapping or misuse of a practice jump will be penalised. Any such act must be reported by any horse/pony steward or judge to the Judicial or General committee. In the interest of safety, the stirrup iron & the stirrup leather (this also applies to safety stirrups), must hang freely from the bar of the saddle and the outside of the flap. The rider must not directly or indirectly tie any part of their body to the saddlery, unless an exhibitor's disability card is held.

HATS & SAFETY HELMETS:

Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in, or schooling or riding a horse/pony in any area considered to be part of the showground. All riders must wear protective headgear with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within the showground. Helmets must meet the required safety standards as of 1 August 2023. The yellow tag must be visible

on helmet harness.

FALL OF RIDER

If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.

SAFETY:

Each Exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Show grounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health and Safety in Work Act 2015; and any amendments thereafter. All competitors compete at their own risk. The Society reserves the right to refuse any competitor's entries without giving a reason.

MOTORBIKES/SCOOTERS:

May be ridden within grounds by licensed holders and not after 10pm. Helmets must be worn and there be no passengers.

DOGS:

Dogs are welcome at our show however they must be kept on leads and supervised at all times, any wandering or unsupervised dogs will be handed over to Carterton City Council Dog Control at the dog owners expense. No warnings will be issued.

MEDIA:

By entering or attending the Wairarapa A & P Show you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there might be live streaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day, there may also be several photographers on the grounds. By entering the grounds you give permission for your photo to be taken and provided on their respective websites/facebook pages at the discretion of the photographer.

Registered Welsh dry mares and geldings entered in Driven and Ridden classes at A & P Shows and shown In hand classes on that day may be plaited, young stock regardless of sections must not be plaited. All entries to be registered with The Welsh Pony & Cob of New Zealand (Inc) in either The Welsh Pony & Cob Society of NZ Stud Book or The Welsh Pony & Cob Society of NZ Partbred Register.

Registered Welsh Purebred must not be plaited in In-hand breed classes unless exhibited in Ridden or driven classes on that day.

Ponies and Cobs must be entered under their fully registered name,

Temporary colts 5 yrs and over are not eligible to be shown.

Temporary colts are not eligible for gelding classes.



PLEASURE HORSE AND PONY CLASSES



From 1 August 2015, for a horse/pony to meet the annual title show qualification requirements they must be registered with NZEPS.

Show pleasure is open to members and non-members alike, but only financial members of NZEPS as of 10/10/2022 are eligible to use any champions/reserves for qualification. Horses/ponies must never have been placed first in an open show ring class. However, members may apply for dispensation to NZEPS.

Ordinary snaffle bit only, no poll action. No bitless bridles permitted. Only cavesson nosebands are permitted. Whips may be carried but must not exceed 76cms in length.

All riders must wear a 3-point harness helmet conforming to the current NZ Safety Standard or an equivalent standard. Spurs are not to be worn.

Riders may be registered with other bodies. Riders may have competed outside the Pleasure Horse/Pony section.

Riders in Pony classes must be under aged 17yrs (proof of rider's age may be requested). Age is taken as at 1st August. Adults may ride ponies in the Horse Classes and children aged 17 and under may ride a hack but must ride in the hack class.

All NZEPS members must provide their passport at time of judging.


