

- **Thoroughbred horse** - registered in any recognised Thoroughbred Stud Book, either in NZ or overseas.
- **Sire and Dam of Thoroughbred** - must be listed at time of entry. If not listed, then the entry will not be accepted the Show/Event.
- **No RAS Horse/Pony ID Certificate (Height Certificate) is required**

Prize Money – 1st \$100; 2nd \$50; 3rd \$30; 4th \$20 will be awarded if 3 or more entries are in the class at close of entry date. 2 entries or less – no prize money awarded.

Ribbons – Awarded to fourth place.

Series Winner 2025.2026 – will be announced at HOY 2026.

Judging: 80% Conformation, 20% Paces & Manners.

Horses to show a good Walk and where space allows a Gallop.

Ridden horses must exhibit true thoroughbred characteristics throughout. Judge then to assess each Horse individually with Saddles removed.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

DOGS: *Must be on a lead at all times.*

IN-LINE RESOLUTION PROCESS POLICY: *This Show supports the RAS In-Line Resolution Process Policy. A Yellow or Red card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible. Full wording of the Policy system, is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz.*

CLEAN SPORT – *The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regards to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests of forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and the testing of all animals is at the person responsible risk. Forbidden Substance – Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.*

ARREARS – *No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show. Proof of payment will be required before any restrictions are lifted.*

SUMMARY OF RAS RESOLUTION PROCESS – *the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. The full policy can be found on the RAS website - <https://www.ras.org.nz/about/our-rules-regulations-and-policies/> The organising committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any classes or start times as they see fit. There may be no lunch break. Judging for showing classes may be continuous at the steward's discretion.*

Ages: *Age of Riders/Handlers is as at 1 August 2025. Horses/Ponies 3 years and under as at 1 August 2025 are not to be ridden.*

HATS AND SAFETY HELMETS

- Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling, or riding for any other reason an exhibit at a RAS affiliated Show/Event or in any area considered to be for whatever reason a part of the Showgrounds.
- All riders, including harness drivers, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds. **Hats/helmets must conform with the current approved safety standards and must be yellow tagged. No yellow tag – no entry to the ring.** These standards may be subject to change, but the latest list can be found at www.ras.org.nz under the equestrian tab. The RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook.

LEGAL LIABILITY: *Our association policy does not cover competitors or exhibitors, each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at ALL times. Exhibitors must comply with Animal legislation and Health and Safety in Employment act.*

ENTRY FEES & CHARGES: *Postal entries received after the closing date will be treated as late entries (NON-REFUNDABLE). Late entries \$5.00 penalty. All prize monies and fees are GST inclusive.*

PROTESTS: *Must be lodged in writing with the secretary, no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event concerned, a deposit of \$30 must accompany EACH protest. Deposit will be refunded if protest is upheld.*

REFUNDS: *No refund will be paid out during the show. Refunds are at the discretion of the organising committee. Entry fees are refunded less 20% if the secretary is notified prior to start of days competition, vet certificate or similar to be supplied if appropriate.*

PRIZE MONEY: *The organising committee reserves the right to alter prize money as it sees fit.*

HORSE ACCOMMODATION: *Overnight yards are available but must book with entry. Absolutely no temporary fencing allowed on the ground.*

GR 8. FALL OF RIDER If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.
