NOTE: Less than 4 entries in any class and classes may be combined. Horse must be registered with the NZ Golden Horse Society. No False tails in any Golden Horse class.

Class 1. Best Presented Horse & handler.

Class 2. Best coloured

Class 3. Best mane & tail Exhibit must be unplaited

Class 4. Best Foal or yearling. Any sex.

Class 5. Best 2 or 3 year old. Any sex.

Champion & Reserve Champion Youngstock Golden Horse (To be judged from the winners of classes 4&5. Second place getters to standby).

Class 6. Best male 4 years & over.

Class 7. Best female 4 years & over.

Champion & Reserve Champion Adult Golden Horse (To be judged from the winners of classes 6& 7 Second place getters to standby).

Supreme Champion Golden Horse To be judged from the Champion youngstock and Champion Adult winners

16. Best Paced & Mannered any height
